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SURVEYORS AFFIDAVIT AND DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARY

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that I F.H.Walker did on March 29-1911 correctly survey the lands shown by map hereon, and properly mark all corners with stakes, and that said map is a proper representation of said Survey as made by me on the ground, and that said survey is tied in to the S.W. Corner of D.L.C. #40 T. 39 S. R. 1 E. of Willamette Meridian, Oregon; which point is marked by an iron pipe driven into the ground.

The outside boundary of this tract is described as follows
Beginning at a point 160.38 South of the S.W. Corner of D.L.C. #40 which point is the
S.W. Corner of tract of land to be described; thence South a distance of 234.3 ft;
thence East 382.95 ft along the South side line of a 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. wide strip of ground set aside for
private road or street, to an intersection with the West side line of Granite Street;
thence Northerly along the west side of Granite Street to a point where a line drawn
parallel to and 145 ft. distant north at right angles from the north line of private
road above described intersects said W. line of Granite St.; thence West along said parallel line a distance of 150 feet;
thence North at right angles 73.25 ft; thence Westerly 277.2 ft to the place of beginning.
