

PLAT OF BOULEVARD PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ASHLAND, OREGON.

**Dedication.**  
 The Boulevard Addition to the city of Ashland, Jackson County, State of Oregon, and is a part of the southwest quarter of Section 10, Township 39 South of Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, and is bounded and particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point which is 719' 5" E, 232' 5" S from the intersection of Mountain Avenue and Ashland Street in the City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon, thence N00° 07' West 430 feet to the center of the Boulevard; thence N00° 11' E, 50 feet to the center of the Boulevard; thence N89° 52' E 295.35 feet to the center of the Boulevard; thence S89° 52' E 417 feet to the place of beginning. The Boulevard is 50 feet wide.  
 The number of said blocks and lots and dimensions of the same are as shown on the accompanying Plat.
