

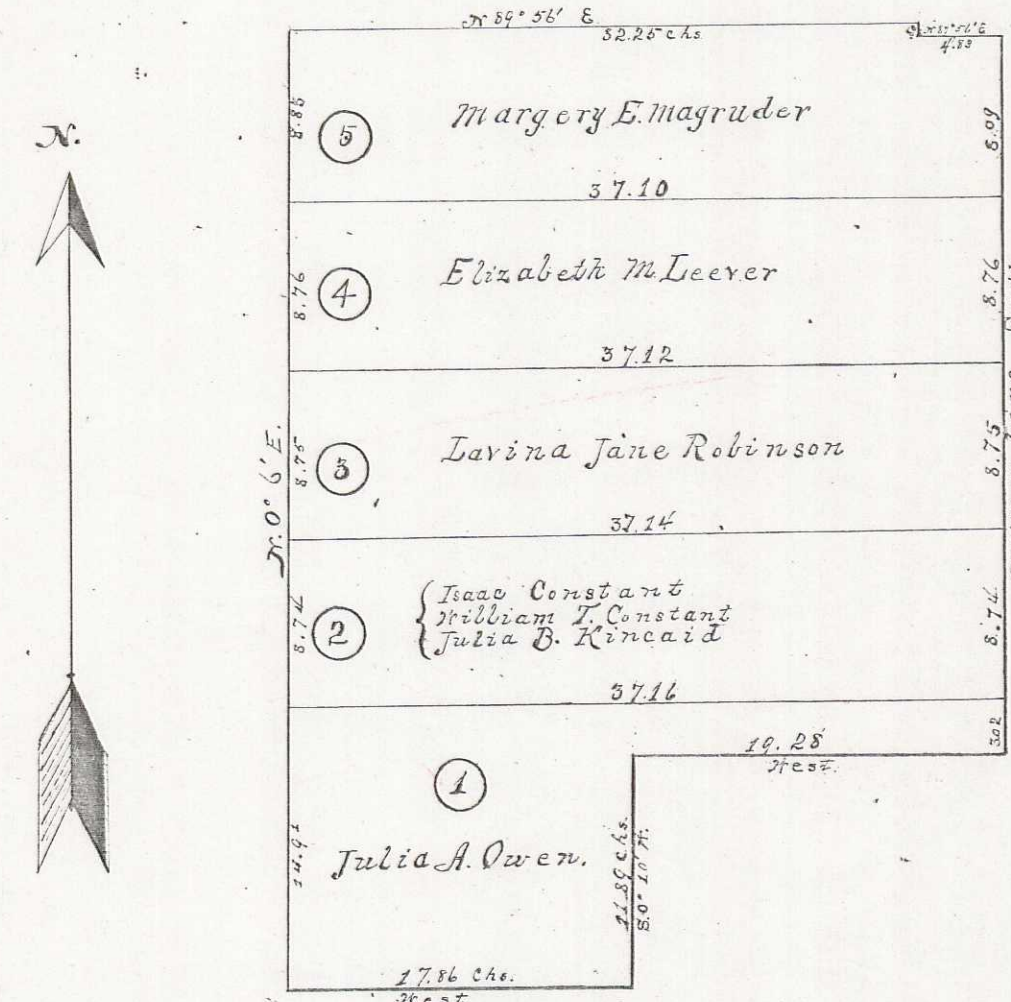
MAP OF

SCALE: 10 CHAINS = 1 INCH.



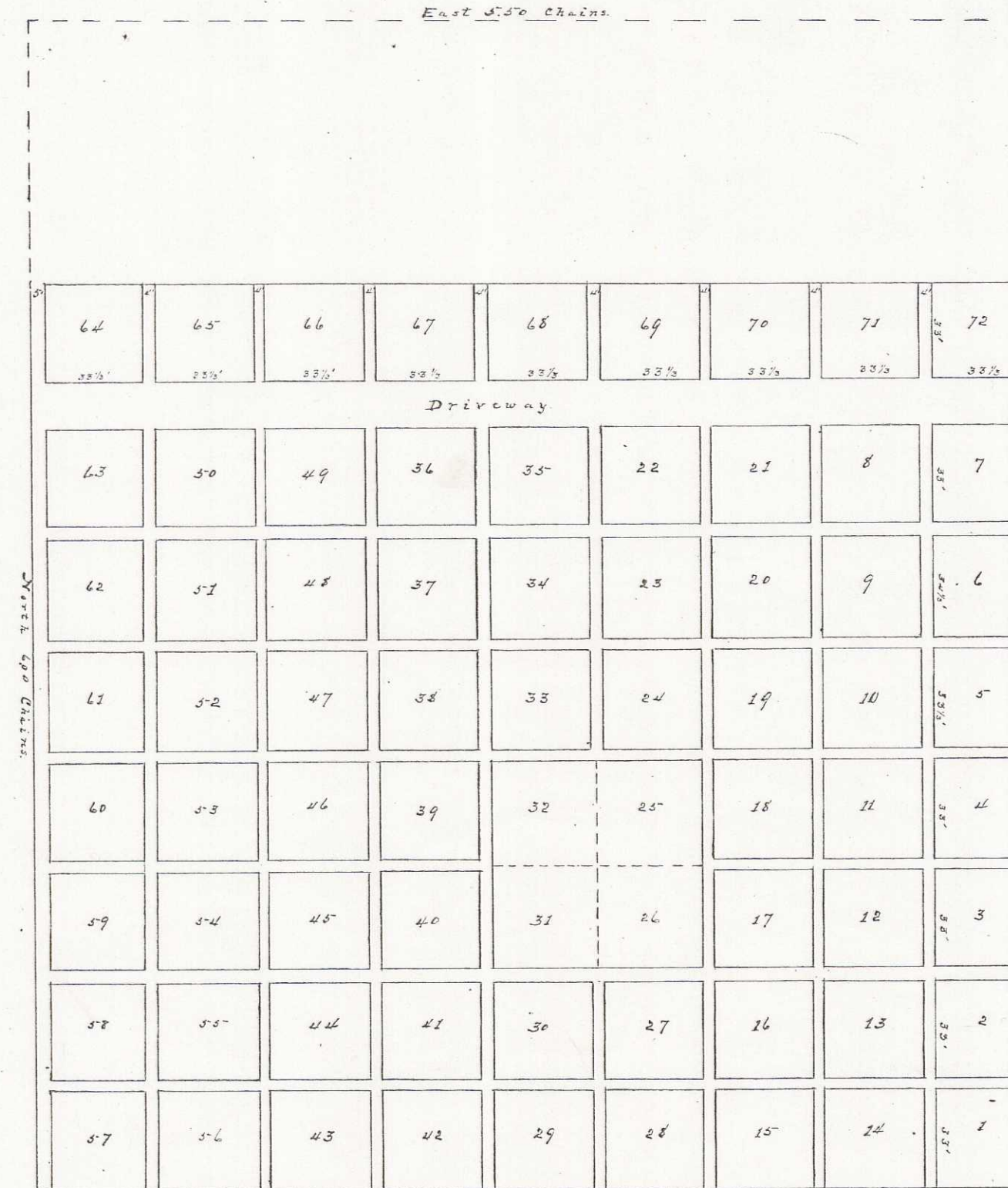

This Central Point Cemetery is a part of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section One in Township thirty-seven South, Range two West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, & is described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the East boundary line of the Keopwood Donation Claim N. 55' in above named Township, a White Oak Tree 12 inches in diameter bears N. 43° E. 125 links, - Thence North 600 chains to a stake from which a Pine 8 inches in diameter bears S 89° E. 105 links, - Thence East 500 chains, - Thence South 600 chains, - Thence West 500 chains to the place of beginning, containing 3.3 acres.
