

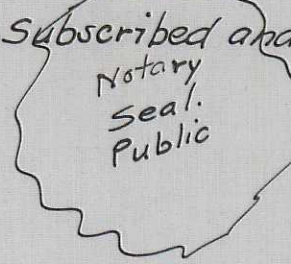

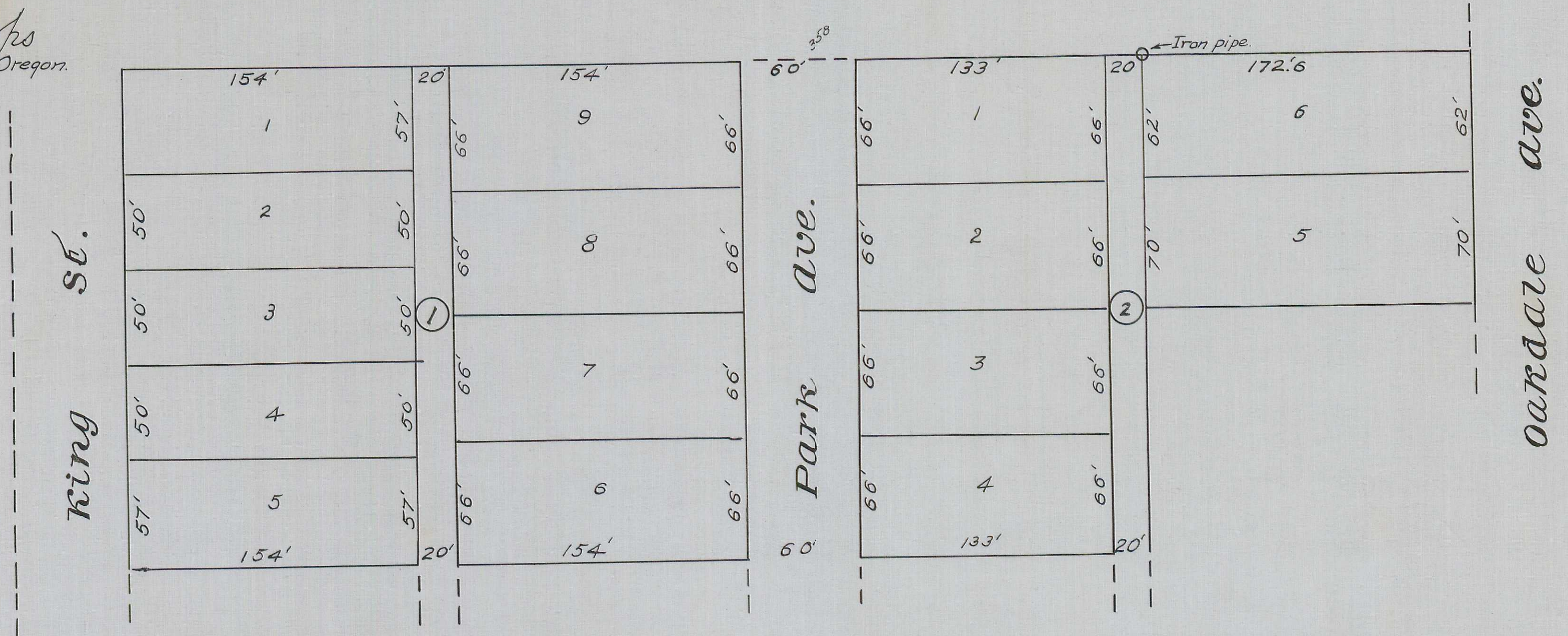

# DODGE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF MEDFORD OREGON



**Description.**  
Commencing of a point which is 1886.1 feet North and 30 feet West of the South West Corner of Donation Land Claim No. 44, Township 37 South Range 1 West W.M. and running thence West 713 feet, thence South on the East line of King St. 264 feet, thence East on the North line of Tuttle's Addition, 541 feet, thence North 132 feet, thence East, 172.82 feet, thence North, on the West line of Oakdale Ave. 132 feet, to the place of beginning, all of which is in block 1 of Barr's Addition.

**Dedication.**  
Know all men by these presents, that we W.F. Dodge and Delia M. Dodge, his wife, and J.M. Dodge, a single man, are the owners in fee simple of the above described tract, and that we have laid out the same into lots, blocks, streets, and alleys as shown by the map hereon, and that same is a correct representation of said survey and subdivision, and that we do hereby dedicate to the public for public use, all the streets and alleys as shown on said plat, and we do hereby designate said plat as the Dodge Addition to the City of Medford, Oregon; said W.F. Dodge and Delia M. Dodge, his wife, owning lots 1, 2, 8, 9, and an undivided half of lot 3, all in Block 1, and lots 1, 2, and 6 all in Block 2; and said J.M. Dodge, an undivided half of lot 3 in Block 1, and lots 4, 5, 6, and 7, in Block 1, and lots 3, 4, and 5 in Block 2.
