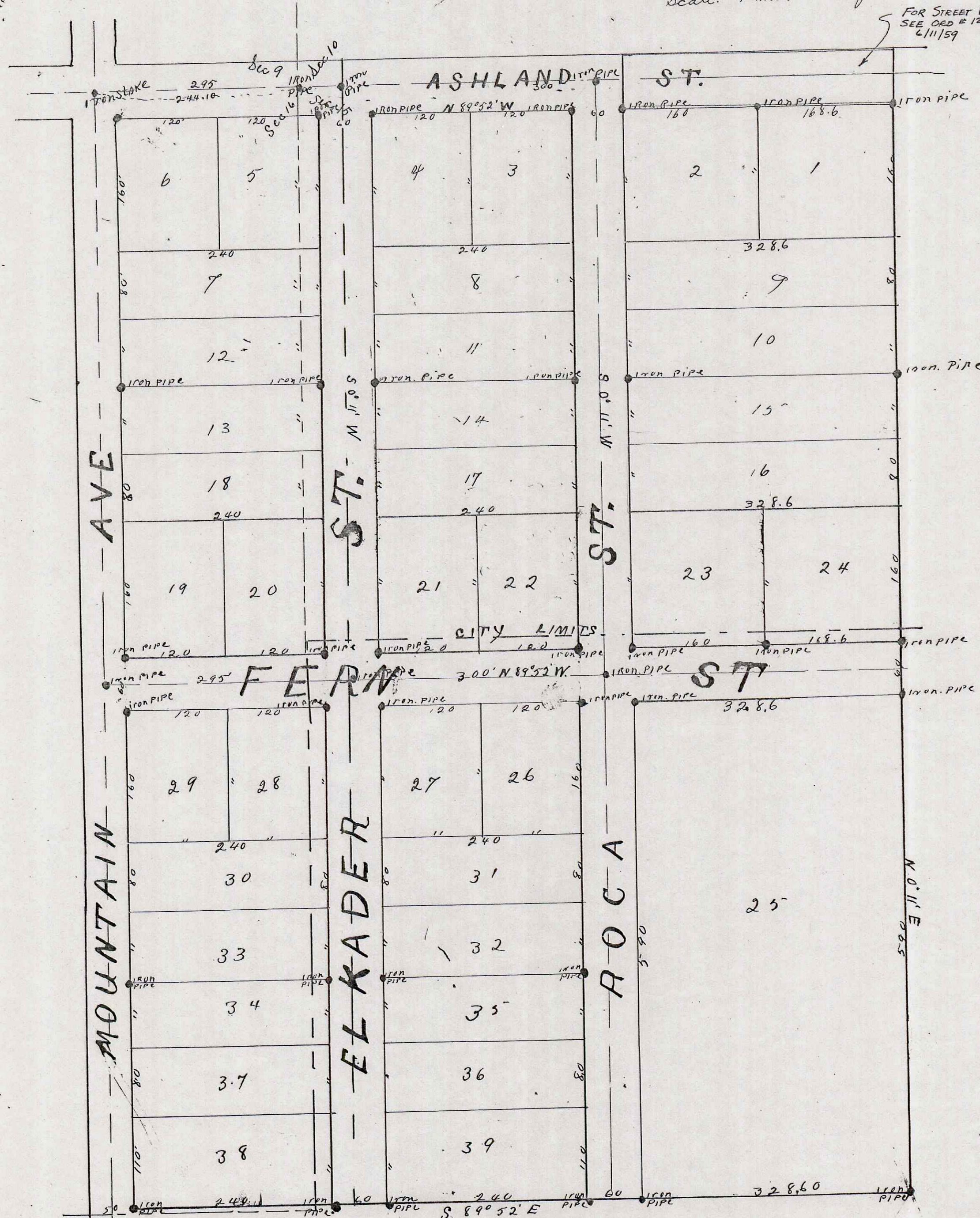


THE GALEY ADDITION

DEDICATION

The Galey Addition to the City of Ashland, Jackson County, State of Oregon, is a part of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section Fifteen (15) and the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section Sixteen (16) in Township Thirty-nine (39) South, Range One (1) East of the Willamette Meridian, and is bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning on the section line between Sections (9) Nine and Sixteen (16) at the intersection of Mountain Avenue and Ashland Street in the City of Ashland, Oregon; thence running South 0° 11' West 1320 to stake for corner; thence S 89° 52' E 953.6 feet to IRON PIPE for corner; thence N 0° 11' E 1320 feet to the center of Ashland Street; thence North 89° 52' West 953.6 feet to the place of beginning, containing 28.90 acres, more or less.

Ashland and Fern Streets run S 89° 52' E. and Mountain Avenue, Elkader and Roca Streets run N. 0° 11' E. All the above streets are 60 feet wide except Mountain Avenue which is 50 feet wide. Said addition is comprised of 39 lots numbered from 1 to 39 inclusive. The dimensions are as shown on the accompanying Plat. The streets are subdivisions are marked by iron pipes driven in the ground where shown on said map.
