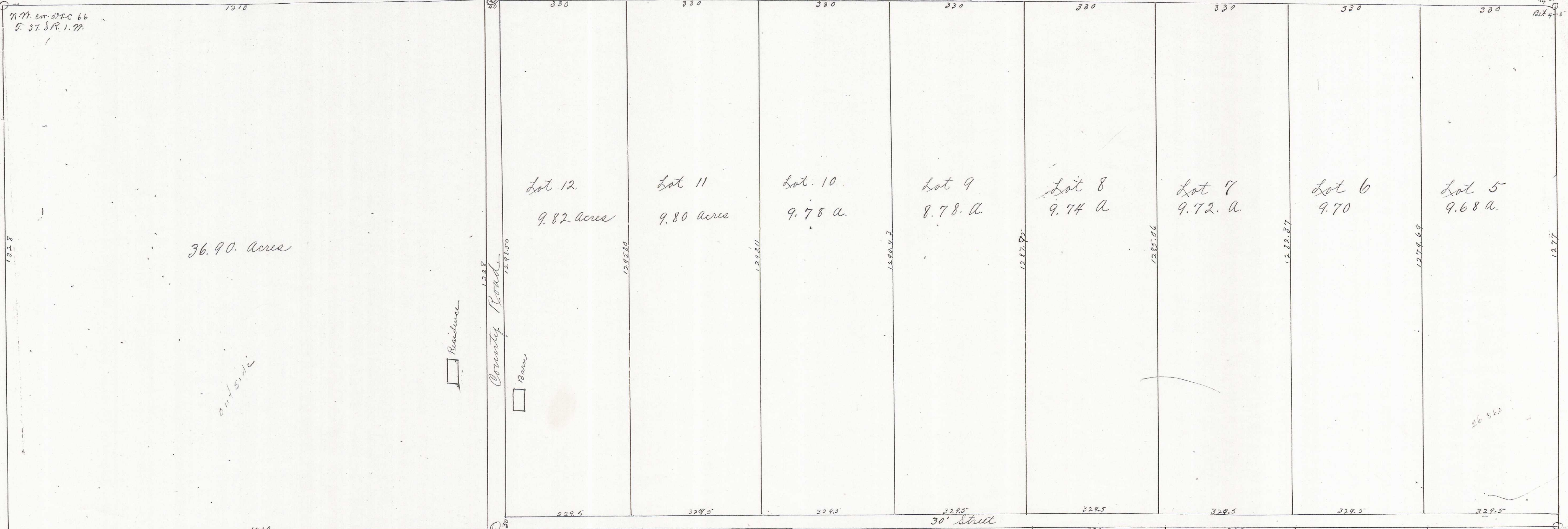


Gilman's Subdivisions.



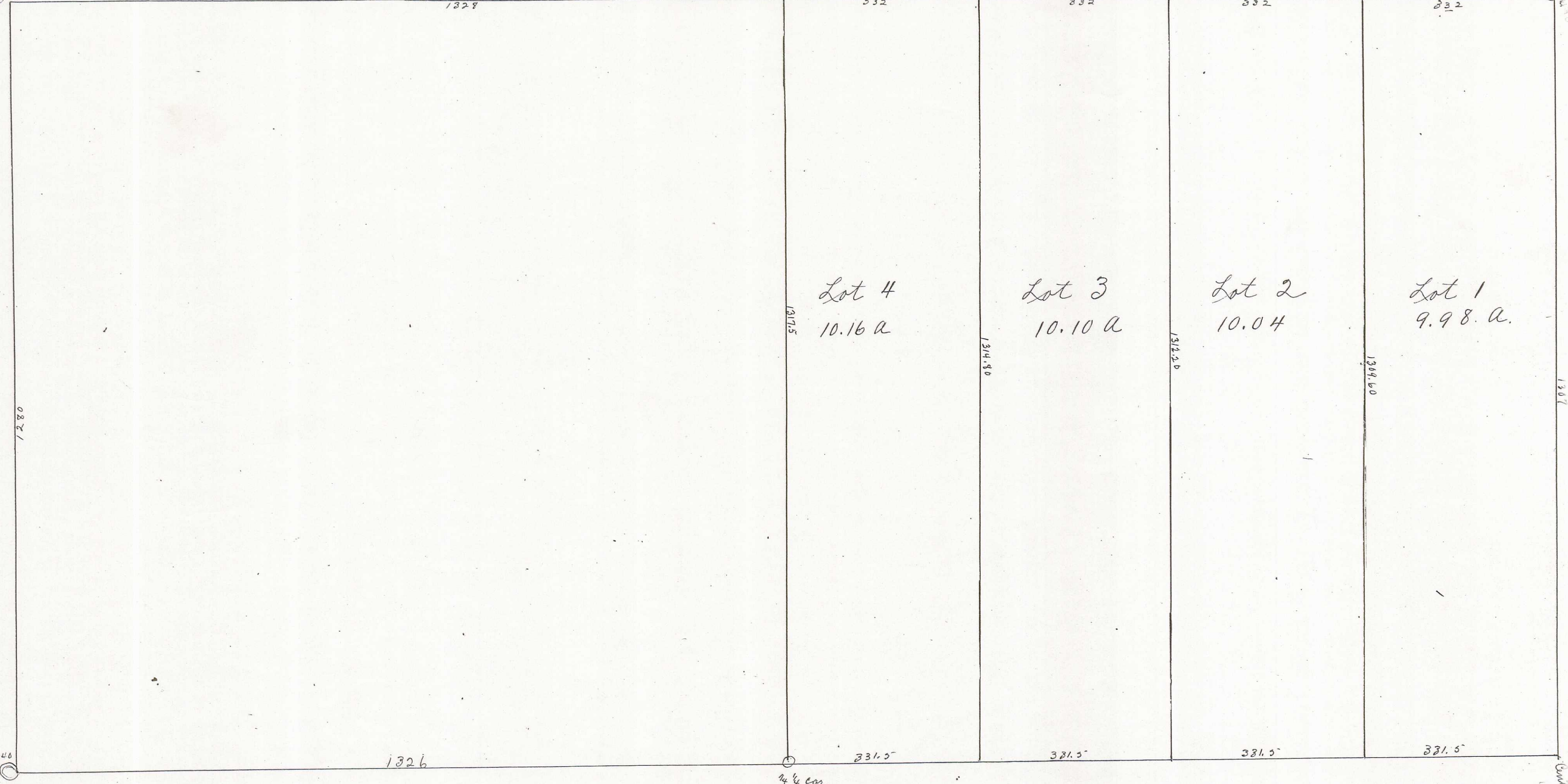
*Description*

*Dedication*

 in fee simple of the above described tract of land, that we have subdivided  
 the same into lots and streets, as shown by the map hereon, and we do hereby  
 designate and name said tract of land as Gilman's Subdivisions, and  
 we do hereby dedicate to the public for use as public highways the street  
 as shown by the map hereon. In witness whereof, we have hereunto
