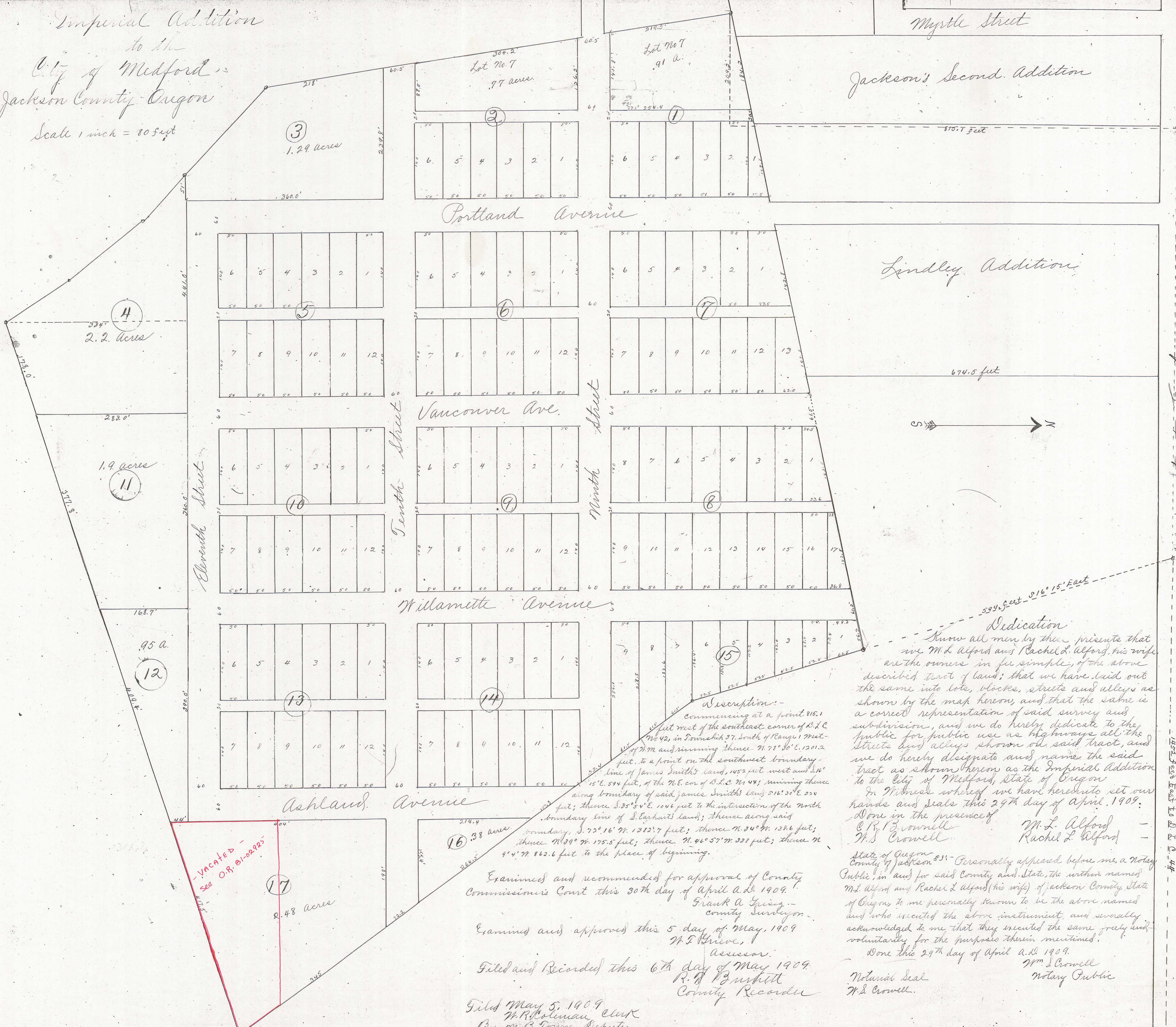


Imperial Addition

M. and running thence N. 71° 36' E. 1201.2 feet, to a point on the southwest boundary line of James Smith's land, 1052 feet west and 216° 15' E. 594 feet, of the N.E. cor. of D. C. No. 42; running thence along boundary of said James Smith's land S. 16° 30' E. 224 feet; thence S. 35° 54' E. 1046 feet to the intersection of the north boundary line of S.
