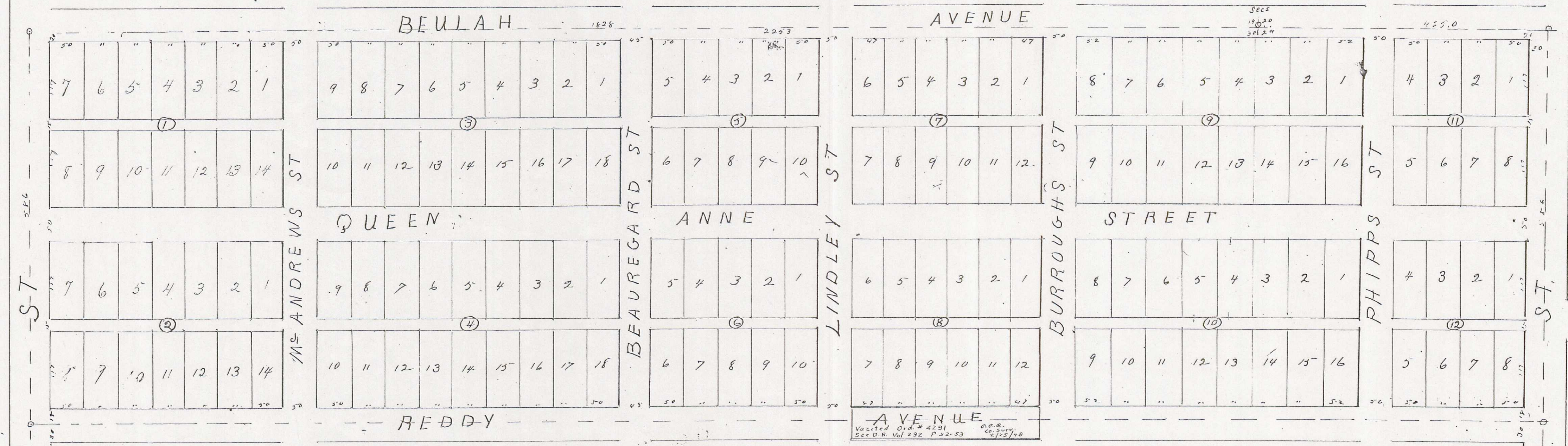

W. 3 of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, State of Oregon, and running thence North 586 feet to the section line between 19 and 30 thence East on section line (1828 feet) to corner to sections 15, 19, 29 and 30) 2253 feet to a post; thence South (439 feet) to the NW corner of Donation Land Claim 52) 586 feet to a post; thence East 2253 feet to the place of beginning
