Description, Beginning at a point on the center line of Main Street West 287.2 feet West of the monument at the intersection of Quince Street North and Main Street West, thence North 30 feet to a point on the North line of Main Street West which is the point of beginning; thence North parallel with Quince Street 759.0 feet to a point on the South line of Fourth Street West; thence West along the South line of Fourth Street West 345.18 feet; thence South 759.0 feet to a point on the North line of Main Street West; thence East on the North line of Main Street West 345.18 feet to the point of beginning.

Dedication, Know all men by these presents, That I Fred H. Cook, an unmarried man, am the owner in fee simple of the above described land; that I have laid out the same into Lots, blocks streets and alleys, as shown by the map hereon and that I hereby dedicate to the Public for public highways all the Streets and Alleys shown on said tract and do hereby designate and name the said tract as shown hereon as the Roanoke Addition to the City of Medford, State of Oregon.
