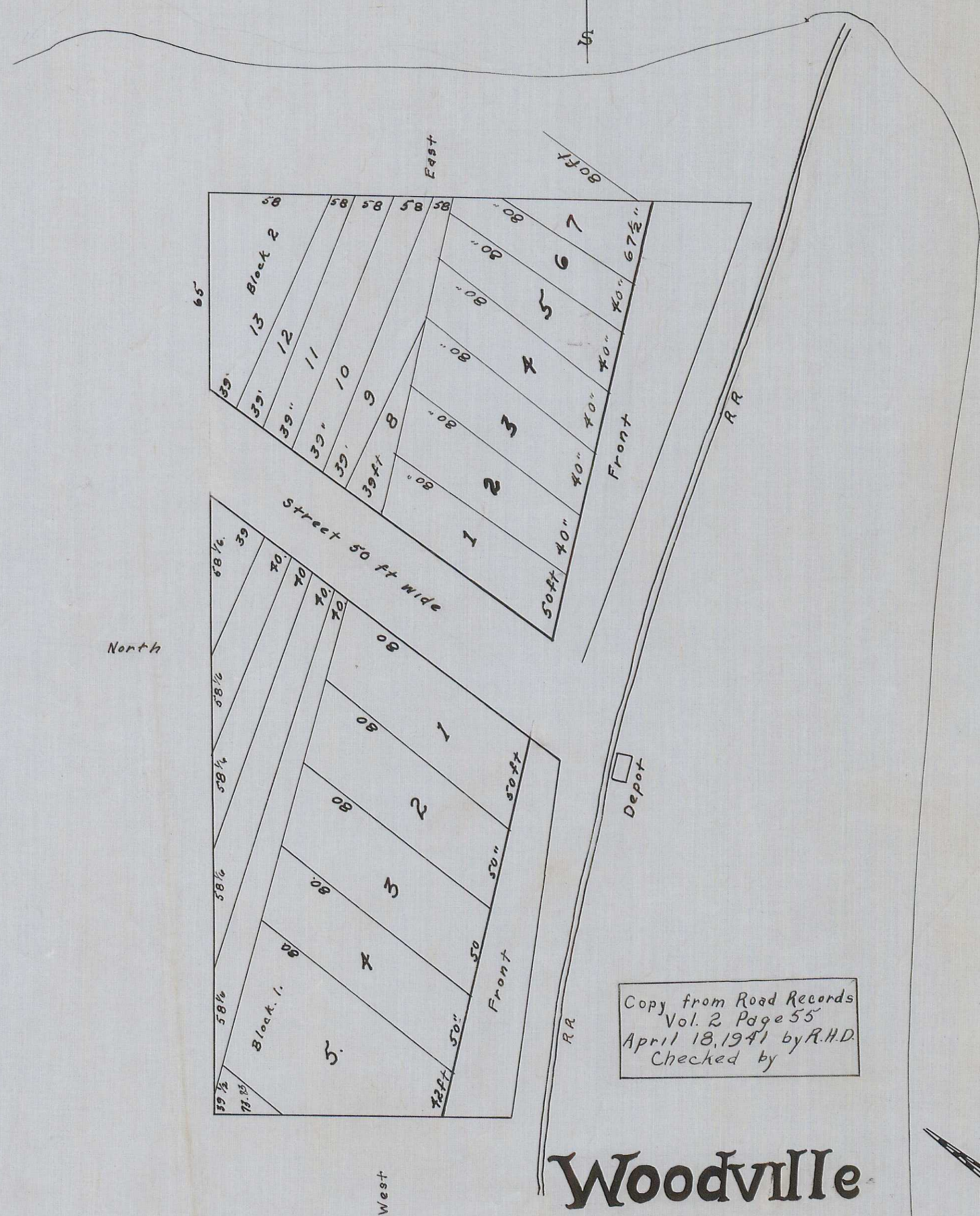
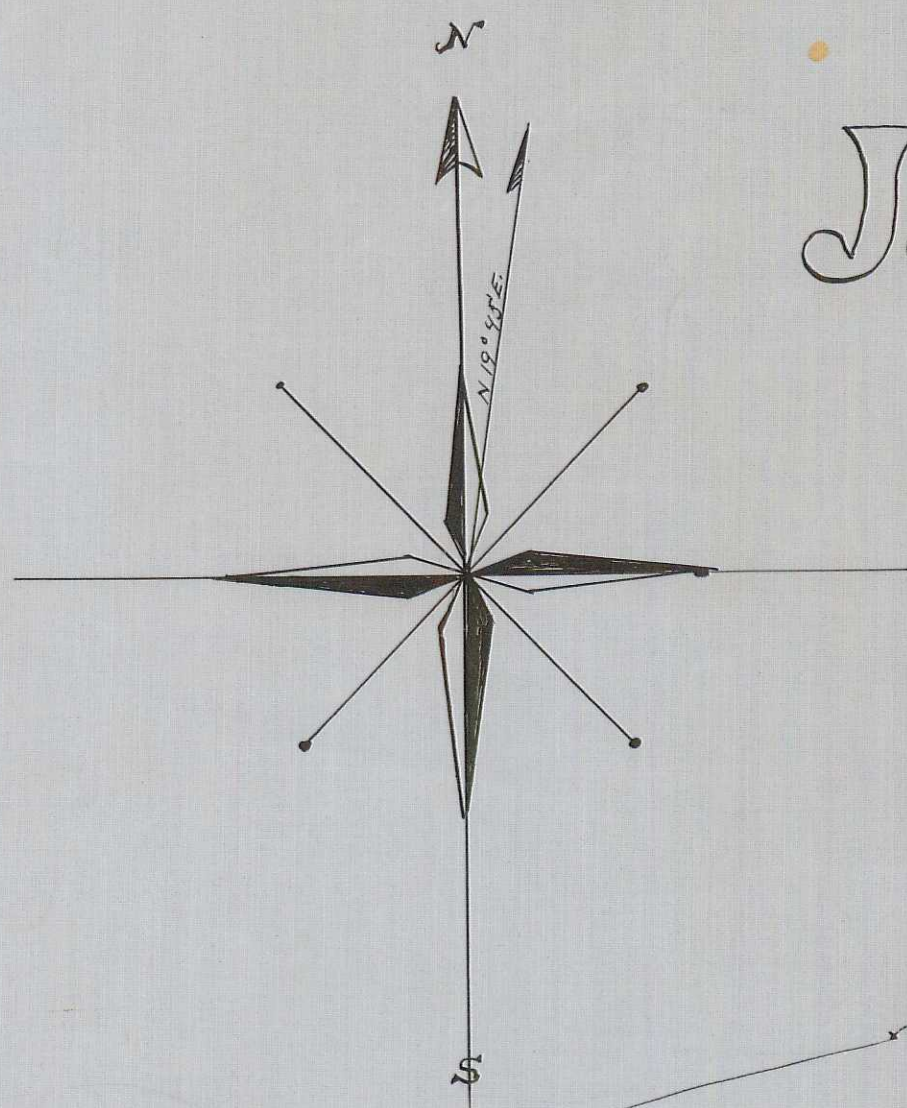
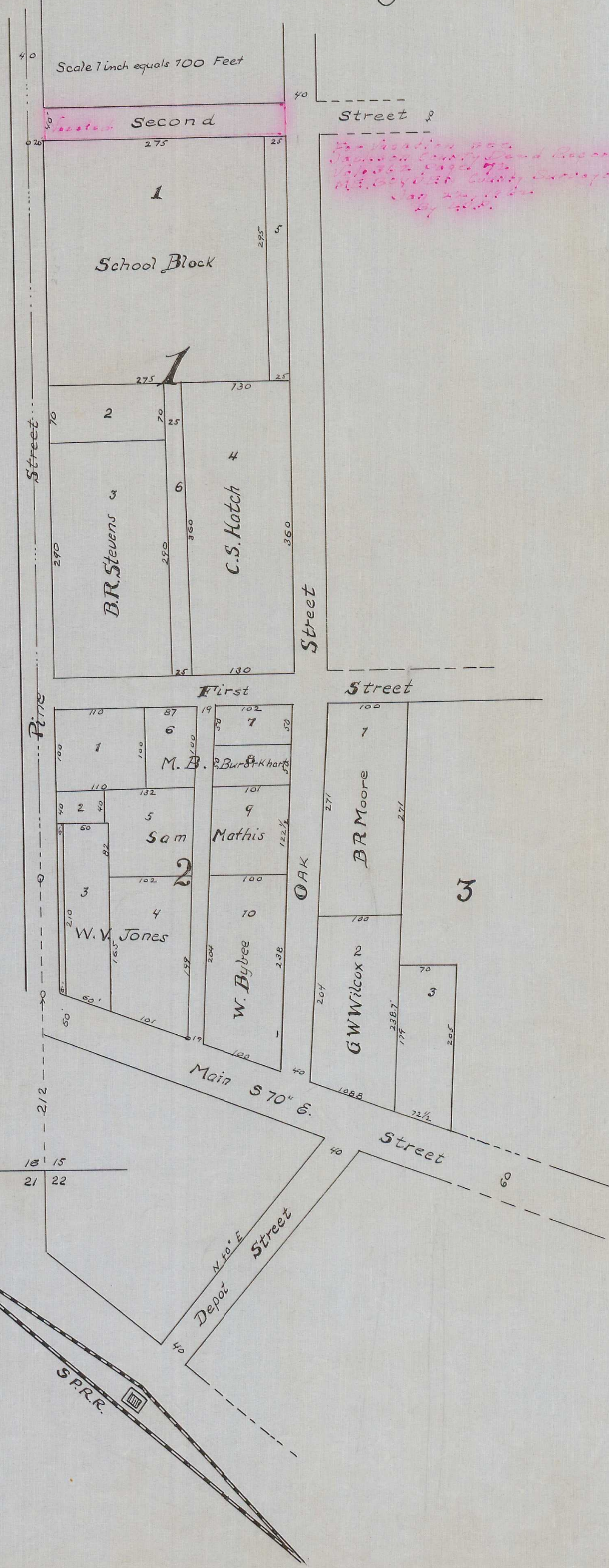


WOODVILLE Jackson County Or.
