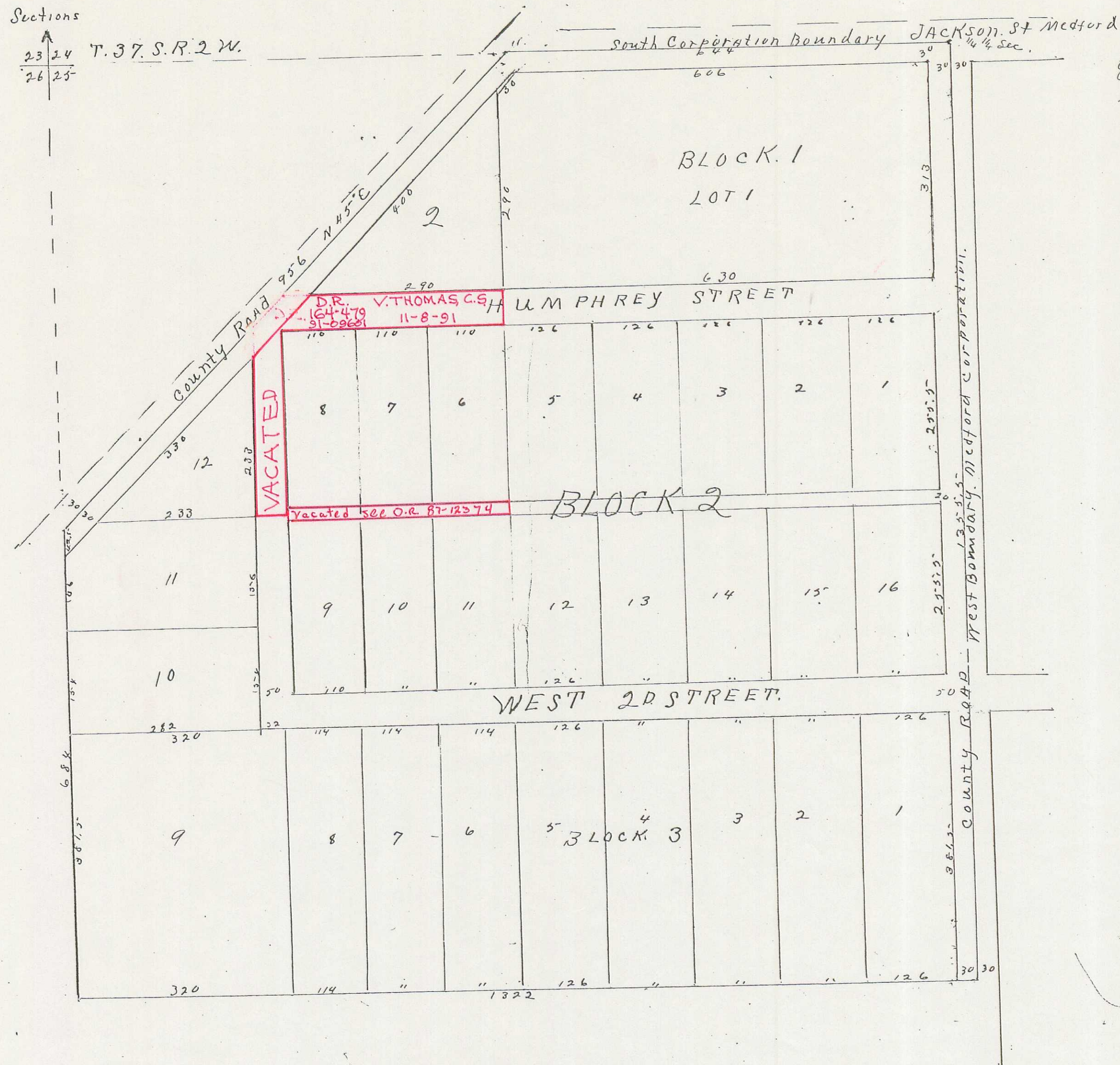


# WEST MEDFORD.



*Description:- Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the County Road 1/4 sec. East of the corner to Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26 in T. 37 S. R. 2 W. of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence East 644 feet to the 1/4 section corner; thence South along the center of the County Road 1355.5 feet; thence West 1332 feet; thence North 684 feet to the center of the County Road; thence N 45° E along the center of the County Road to the place of beginning 456 feet.*

*Dedication:- I know all men by these presents, that we, William Ross and Maggie Ross, husband and wife, and Henry Humphrey and Elizabeth Humphrey, husband and wife, are the owners in fee simple of the above described tract of land; that we have laid out the same into blocks, lots, streets and alleys as shown by the map hereon, and that said map is a correct representation of said survey and subdivisions and the numbers of the blocks and lots, and all subdivisions in part are marked in figures hereon, and that we do hereby dedicate to the public for Public Highways all of the streets and alleys as shown on said map, aforesaid, and the numbers of the streets are plainly shown on said map, and we do hereby designate and name said tract as West Medford. Said tract joins the West corporate limits of said City of Medford on its East boundary.*
