 This town is laid out as follows to wit Beginning at a point at the North Eastern End of Main Street and Set a soft lime rock in the center of Said Street from which the corner of Sections 28, 29, 31, 32 bears N 59<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>° E 17, 12 Chains. (Said rock being 20 in + 7 + 7 inches marked with a + on the top and also on the North side) from said point run thence S. 40° 54' W on center line of Main Street 2.00 feet to the SW End of Said Street and Set a soft lime rock 22 + 9 + 9 inches and marked with a + on the top and also upon the North Side thence 30 feet on Each Side of Said line for the width of the Street For distances Size of Blocks + Lots, width of Streets etc. refer to the plat
