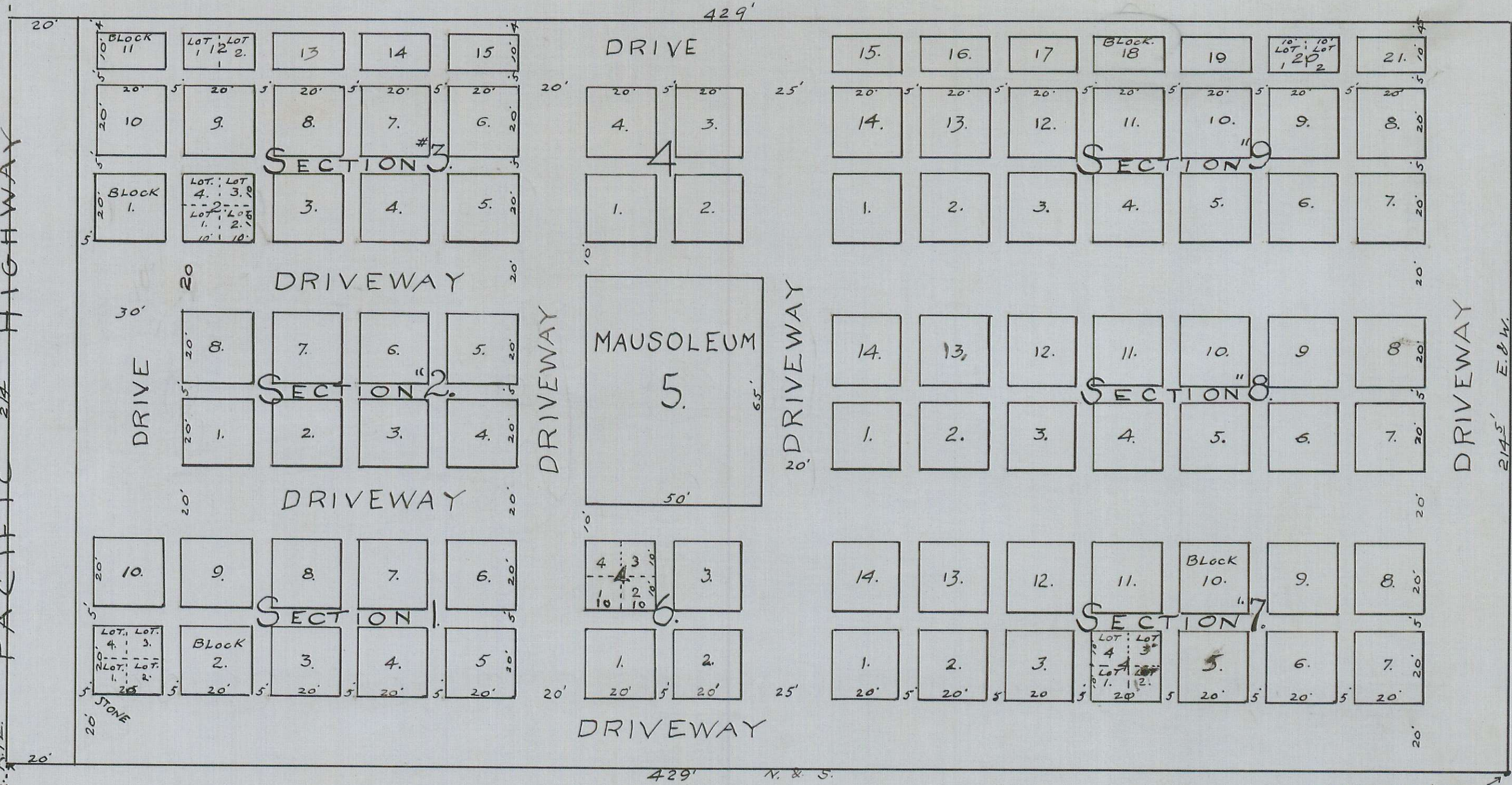


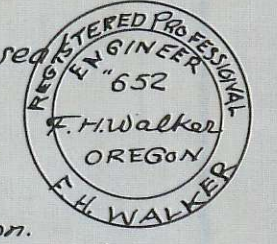

Surveyors Affidavit and Description of Boundary
 This is to certify that I F. H. Walker did on Feb. 12, 1925, have correctly surveyed the lands as shown by Map hereon, being a part of Sec. 15 T. 39 S. R. 1 E. W. M. O.
