


PLAT OF
Woolens Addition
TO THE CITY OF
Ashland



Know all men by these presents, that whereas on or about the month of March 1880 being the owners and holders of an unencumbered Estate in fee simple in and to the following described real Estate to wit the South-west one fourth of the South-east one fourth of Section five (5) in Township Thirty-nine (39) South Range One (1) East of the Willamette Meridian, we did cause the said premises to be surveyed, laid off and platted as "Woolens Addition to Ashland" and where as we did also cause to be made a map or plat of said addition as so laid off and platted by us which was by us filed in the office of the County Clerk in and for Jackson County Oregon and the same was by him attached to page 22 of Volume 2 of the records of roads and highways in his office, where the same still remains, and whereas said map or plat was not signed or acknowledged by us and was otherwise incomplete and defective, all of which defects were caused by oversight and mistake. Now therefore in order to correct said plat and to cure the defects thereof we do hereby publish the foregoing map or plat, and we do acknowledge and declare the same to be a correct map or plat of said addition as originally laid out and platted by us as aforesaid and forsooth and we do hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever all of the streets and alleys as designated upon said map or plat.

McCall surveyor, do hereby certify that on or about the Month of March A.D. 1880 at the request and by the direction of Isaac Woollen, I surveyed Woolens Addition to the city of Ashland as shown upon the foregoing map or plat. Said addition is located upon and comprises all of the South-West quarter of the South-East quarter of Section five (5) in Township Thirty-Nine (39) South, Range One (1) East of the Willamette Meridian, and is divided into Thirty-Two (32) lots numbered from one to thirty-two, both inclusive, as shown and numbered upon said map. "West street" is Forty (40) feet in width and its course is East and West. That portion of "Wimer" street included in said plat is Twenty (20) feet in width and its course is east and west. "North" street and "South" street are each Forty (40) feet in width and their courses are North Thirty-minutes West. That portion of "Woolen" street included within said plat is Thirty (30) feet in width and its course is North-Thirty minutes West. All alleys are Thirty feet in width and their courses are the same as the courses of the streets to which they are parallel. The length of boundary lines of all lots is indicated by figures denoting feet made upon the inside of such lines. The courses of the boundary lines of all lots are the same as the courses of the streets to which they are parallel. And I hereby certify that the annexed and foregoing map or plat is a correct map or plat of said addition as so surveyed by me as aforesaid.
