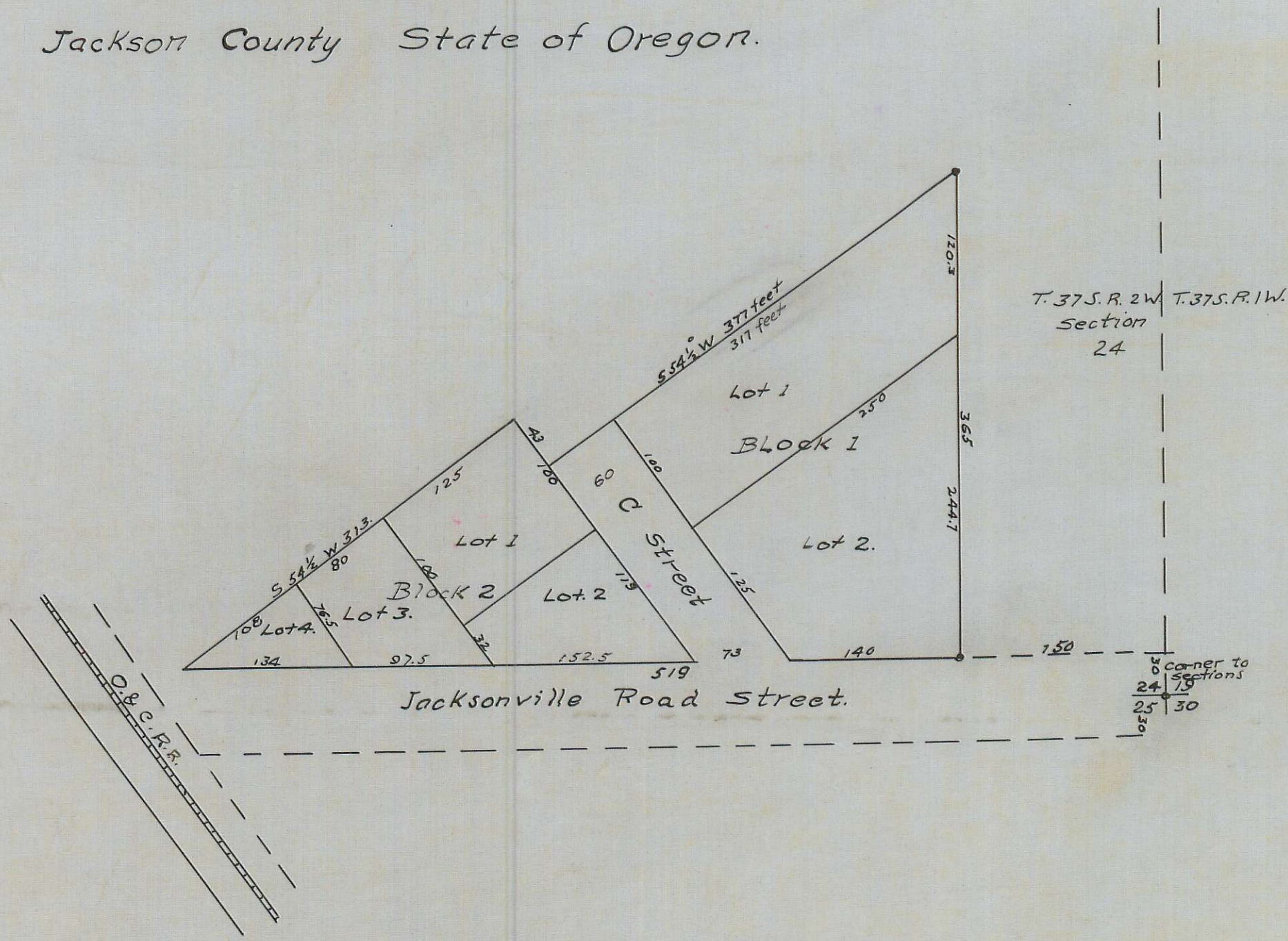


Plat of the WHITNEY ADDITION

I, J.S. Howard County Surveyor of Jackson County State of Oregon do hereby certify that on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1889 did at the request of Mrs - Whitney survey out the above named Addition to Medford Oregon, the outside boundaries of which are as follows to-wit; Commencing at a post on the North boundary of the Jacksonville Road Street 150 feet west and 30 feet North of the corner to sections 24, 25, 19 and 30, T. 37. S. Ranges 1 & 2 West and running thence North 365 feet, thence S. 54 1/2° W. 377 feet to the west boundary of "C" Street; thence N. 35 1/2° W. 43 feet thence S. 54 1/2° W. 313 feet; thence East along the north boundary of the Street 519 feet to the place of beginning, The subdivisions of said tracts into Blocks Lots and Street is fully shown on the plat here unto annexed as surveyed by me upon the ground upon the day aforesaid, and I hereby certify that the above Plat and description is correct.
