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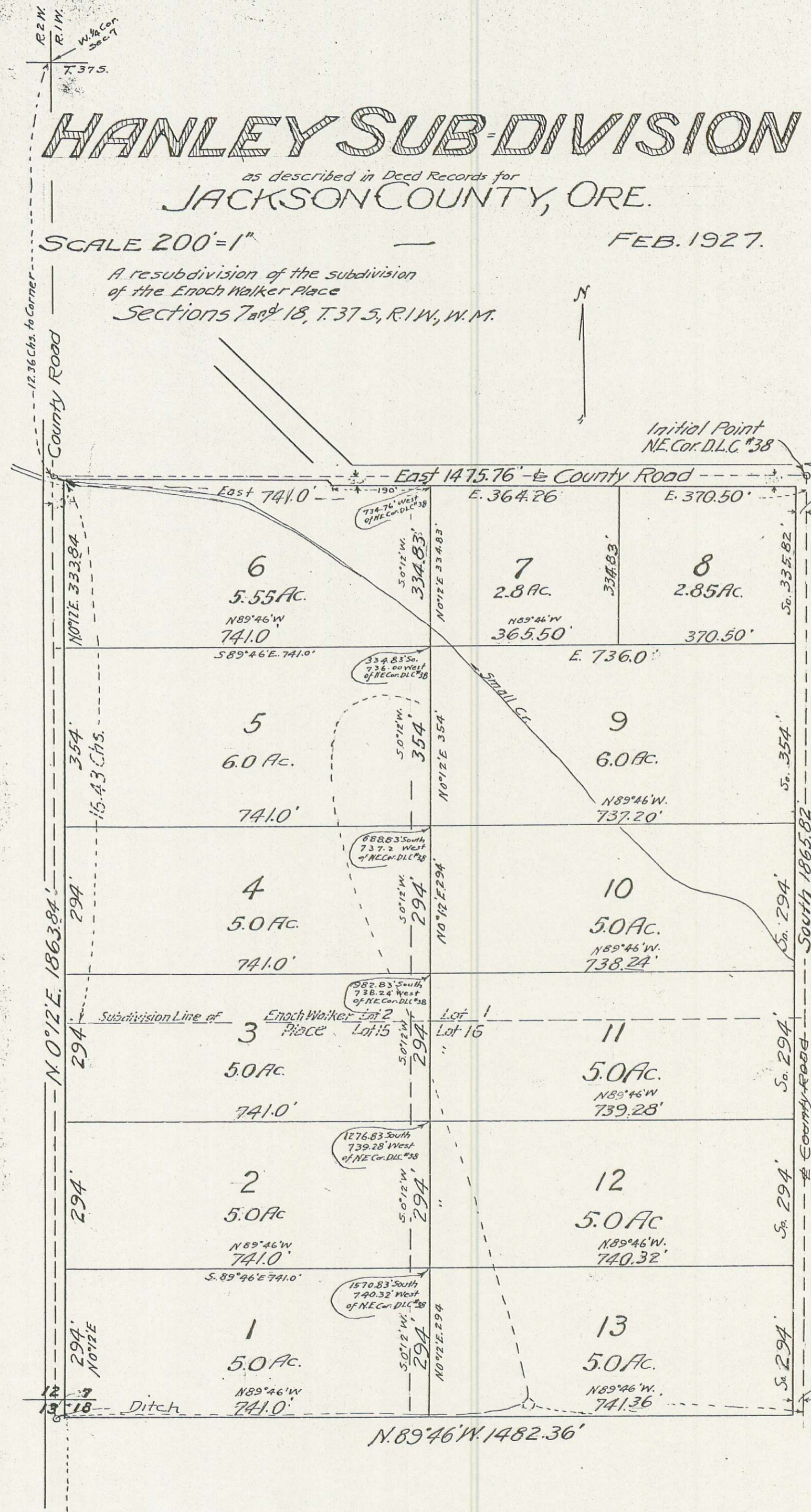
HANLEY SUB-DIVISION

The land is situated in Jackson County, Oregon and included in what is known as the Enoch F. Walker Subdivision, in section 7, and 18, T. 37 S., R. 1 W., W. M., to wit: Beginning at a point 28 Chs. and 27 lks. (1865.82 feet) south of the northeast corner of D.L.C. #38, in sections 7 and 18, T. 37 S., R. 1 W., W. M.; thence N. 89° 46' W., 22 Chs. and 46 lks. (1482.36 feet) to the east line of the Louis Niedermeyer place; thence North 0° 12' East 28 Chs. and 24 lks. (1863.84 feet) to the north boundary line of D.L.C. #38; thence east along said boundary line 22 Chs. and 36 lks. (1475.76 feet) to the northeast corner of D.L.C. #38; thence south along the east boundary of said D.L.C. #38, 28 Chs. and 27 lks.
