Description. From a Point on the center line of Main Street West 632.38 feet west of the monument at the intersection of Quince Street North and Main Street West, thence North 30 feet to a point on the North line of Main Street West to the point of beginning; thence North parallel with Quince Street 759.0 feet to a point on the South line of Fourth Street West; thence West along the South line of Fourth Street West 345.18 feet; thence South 759.0 feet to a point on the North line of Main Street West; thence East along the North line of Main Street West 345.18 feet to the point of beginning.

Dedication. ... Know all men by these presents, that we, C. D. Woolverton and M. A. Woolverton, (his wife) are the owners in fee simple of the above described land; that we have laid out the same into lots, blocks, streets and alleys as shown by the map hereon; and that said map is a correct representation of said survey and sub-division and we do hereby dedicate to the public for public highways all the streets and alleys shown on said tract and do hereby designate and name the said tract as shown hereon as the Woolverton Subdivision to the City of Medford, State of Oregon.
