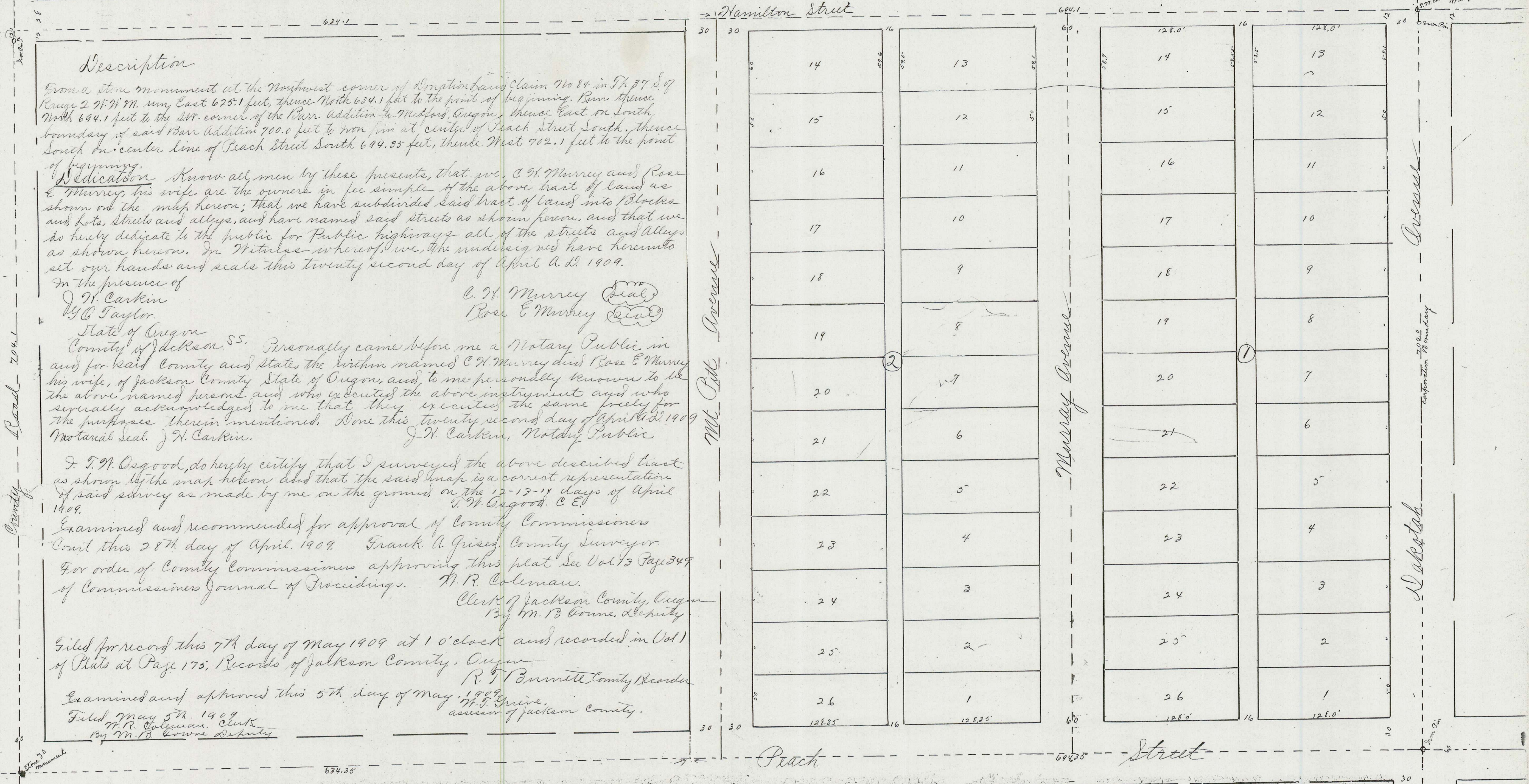
Westmoreland Addition to the City of Medford, Oregon.

Description

From a stone monument at the Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No 84 in T. 37 S. of Range 2 W. 11. M. run East 625.1 feet, thence North 634.1 feet to the point of beginning. Run thence North 694.1 feet to the S.W. corner of the Barr Addition to Medford, Oregon, thence East on South boundary of said Barr Addition 700.0 feet to iron pin at center of Prach Street South, thence South on center line of Prach Street South 694.35 feet, thence West 702.1 feet to the point of beginning.

Dedication. Know all men by these presents, that we, C. W. Murray and Rose E. Murray, his wife, are the owners in fee simple of the above tract of land as shown on the map hereon; that we have subdivided said tract of land into blocks and lots, streets and alleys, and have named said streets as shown hereon, and that we do hereby dedicate to the public for Public highways all of the streets and alleys as shown hereon.
