Thence South 2444.1 feet to an iron pipe a corner of said D.L. Claim N^o 58. Thence West 1217.1 feet to an iron pipe at East Line of Highway Thence North 1687.7 feet along East line of Highway to an iron pin on North line of Road. Thence West 30.0 feet to iron pin on D.L.
