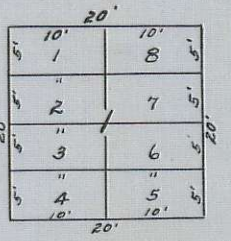


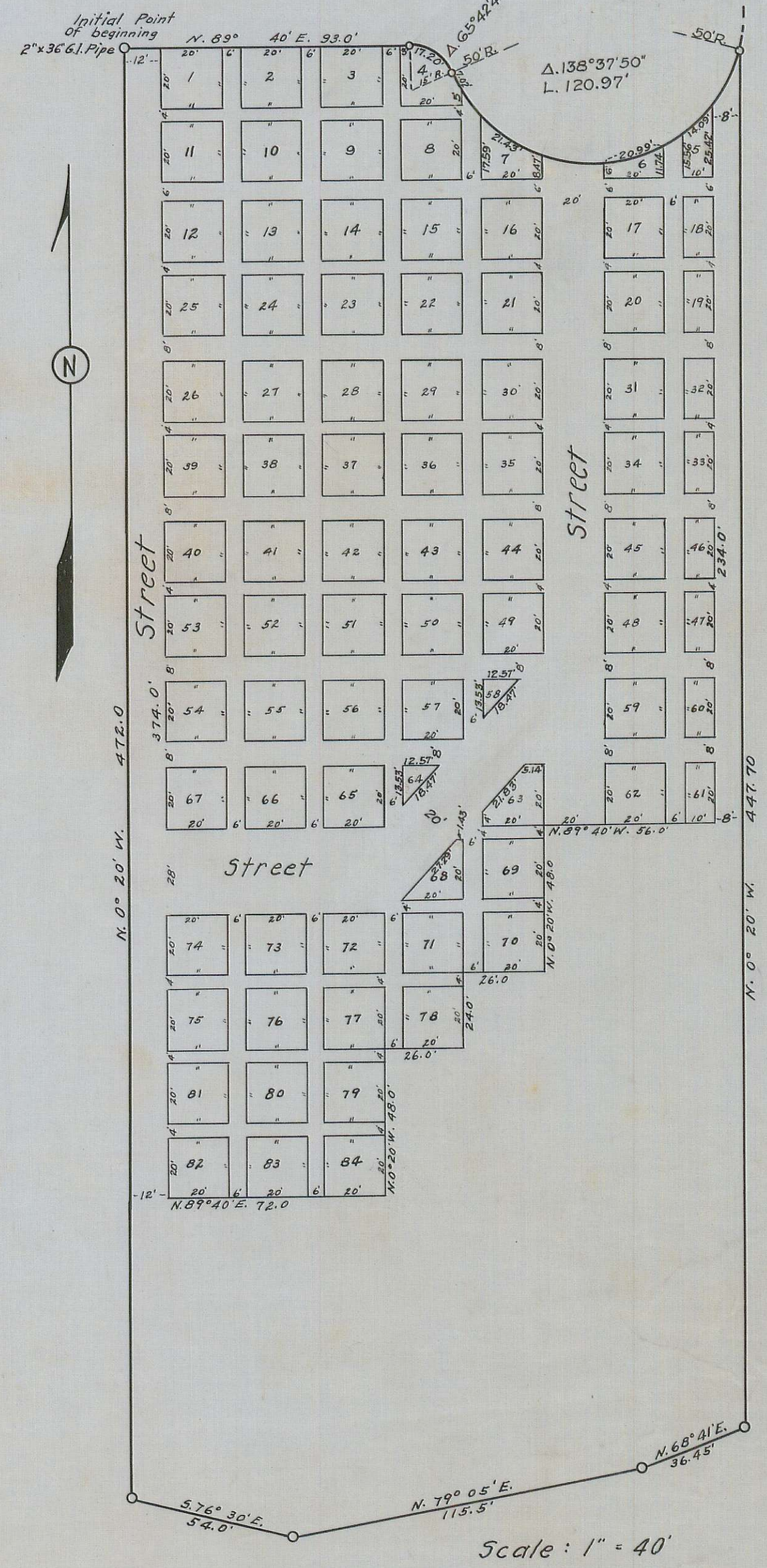

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Jacksonville Lodge #10 - I.O.O.F. Jacksonville, Ore are the owners in fee simple of the Lands hereon described, and that we have subdivided the same into Lots, Blocks and Streets, and lengths of all lines are plainly set fourth, and that this plat is a correct representation of the said subdivision and we do hereby dedicate to the public for public use all streets and alleys shown hereon and we do hereby designate said subdivision as SECTION "B" OF FIRST ADDITION TO JACKSONVILLE CEMETERY FOR I.O.O.F. SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

I, L.E. Ager, a duly registered surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the survey made by me on the ground; that I planted a proper monument as provided by law, a two inch by thirty six inch galvanized iron pipe set six inches below the surface of the ground indicating the initial point of said survey, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines of the subdivision:
Beginning at an iron pipe at the northwest corner of Section "B" of First Addition to Jacksonville Cemetery as shown in Plat Book 5, Page 59, County Recorder's Office, Medford, Jackson County, Oregon; thence S. 0° 20' E. 472.0 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 76° 30' E. 54.0 feet; thence N. 79° 05' E. 115.5 feet; thence N. 68° 41' E. 36.45 feet; thence N. 0° 20' W. 447.7 feet to the south line of said

Section "A"; thence along the arc of a 50 foot radius curve to the right, a distance of 120.97 feet, (long chord bears S. 86° 03' 54" W. 93.55 feet); thence along the arc of a 15 foot radius curve to the left a distance of 17.20 feet, (long chord bears N. 57° 29' 30" W. 16.28 feet); thence S. 89° 40' W. 93.0 feet to the point of beginning.
