DESCRIPTION. Beginning at the North West Corner of DONATION LAND CLAIM N° 61. Tp 37 S. R 2. W.W.M. Said point being marked by a 4" Brass Capped Monument, Thence N 0° 03' W 33.0 feet to a 2" iron pipe, Thence S 69° 05' W 741.8 feet to Corner marked by an angle iron. Thence S 21° 02' E 511.6 feet to corner marked by iron pin. Thence N 68° 58' E 100.0 feet to corner marked by iron pin. Thence S 21° 02' E 139.1 feet to corner marked by 1 1/2" iron pipe, Thence N 34° 04' E 653.7 feet to corner marked by 2" iron pipe, said point being on line of D.L.C. Thence along said D.L.C. line N 0° 03' W 261.6 feet to the point of beginning.

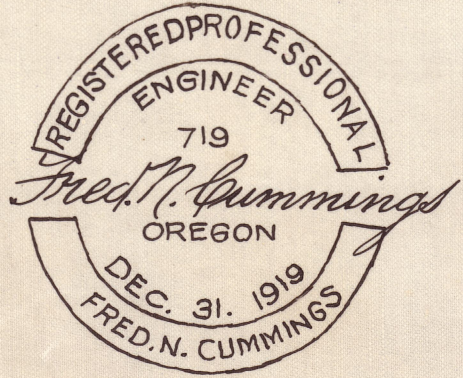
