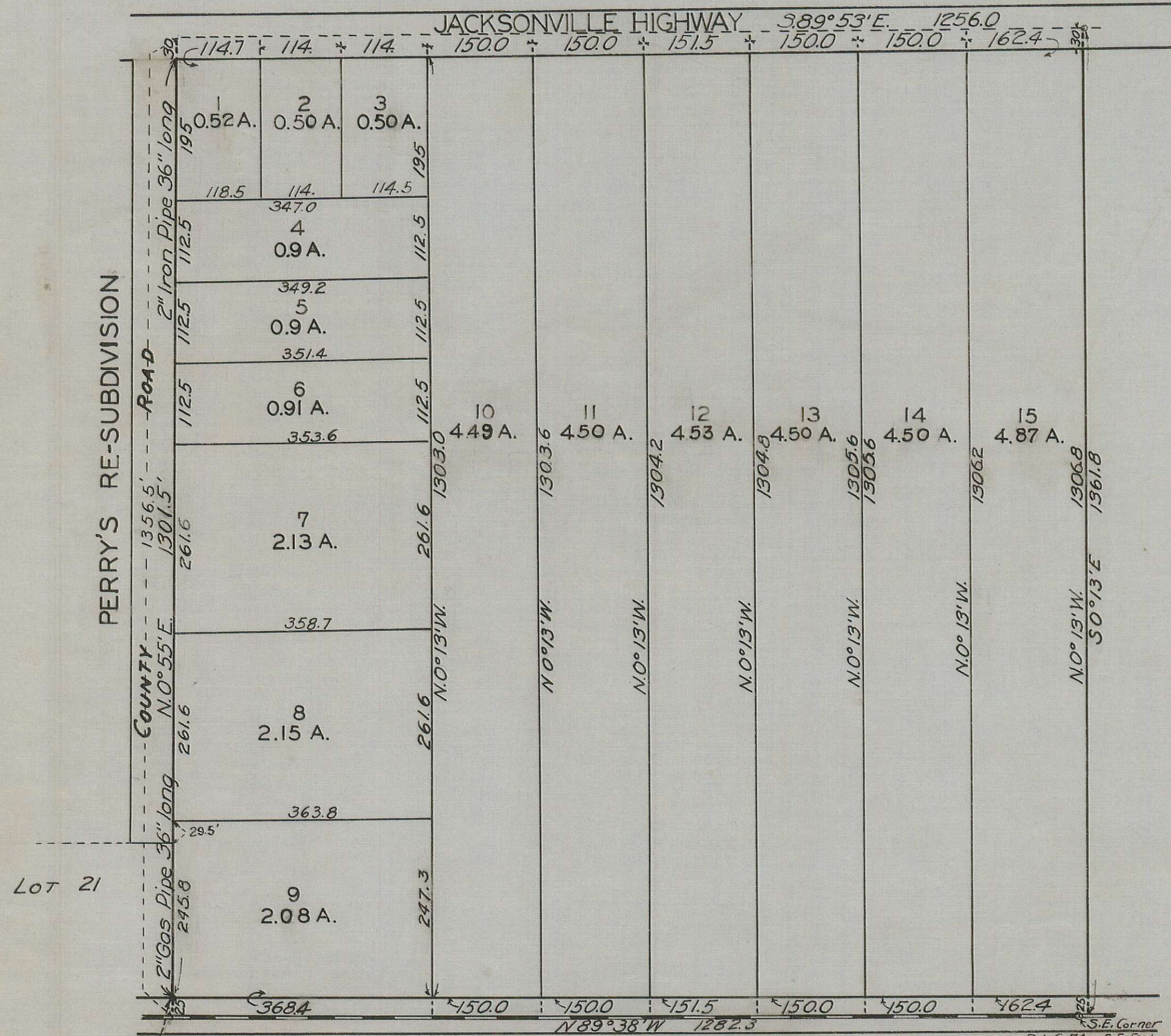


**PERRY'S SECOND SUBDIVISION**

**DESCRIPTION**

Beginning at a 2 inch iron pipe 36 inches long which is North 0° 55' East 25.0 feet from a point on the center line of the right of way of the Medford - Jacksonville Railroad, said point being the South East Corner of Lot 21, Perry's Re-Subdivision, and further described as being North 89° 38' West 1277.3 feet from the South East Corner of Donation Land Claim # 74, in Township 37 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon; and from said point running thence North 0° 55' East 1326.5 feet to a 2 inch iron pipe 36 inches long which is South 0° 55' West 30 feet from a point on the center line of the Medford-Jacksonville Highway, which point is the North West Corner of this described tract; and from said North West Corner running thence South 89° 53' East along said center line of the Highway 1256.0 feet; thence South 0° 13' East 1361.8 feet to the South Line of said D.L.C. 74; thence North 89° 38' West along said South Line 1279.2 feet to the said South East Corner of Lot 21, Perry's Re-Subdivision; thence North 0° 55' East 25.0 feet to the place of beginning.

**DEDICATION**
