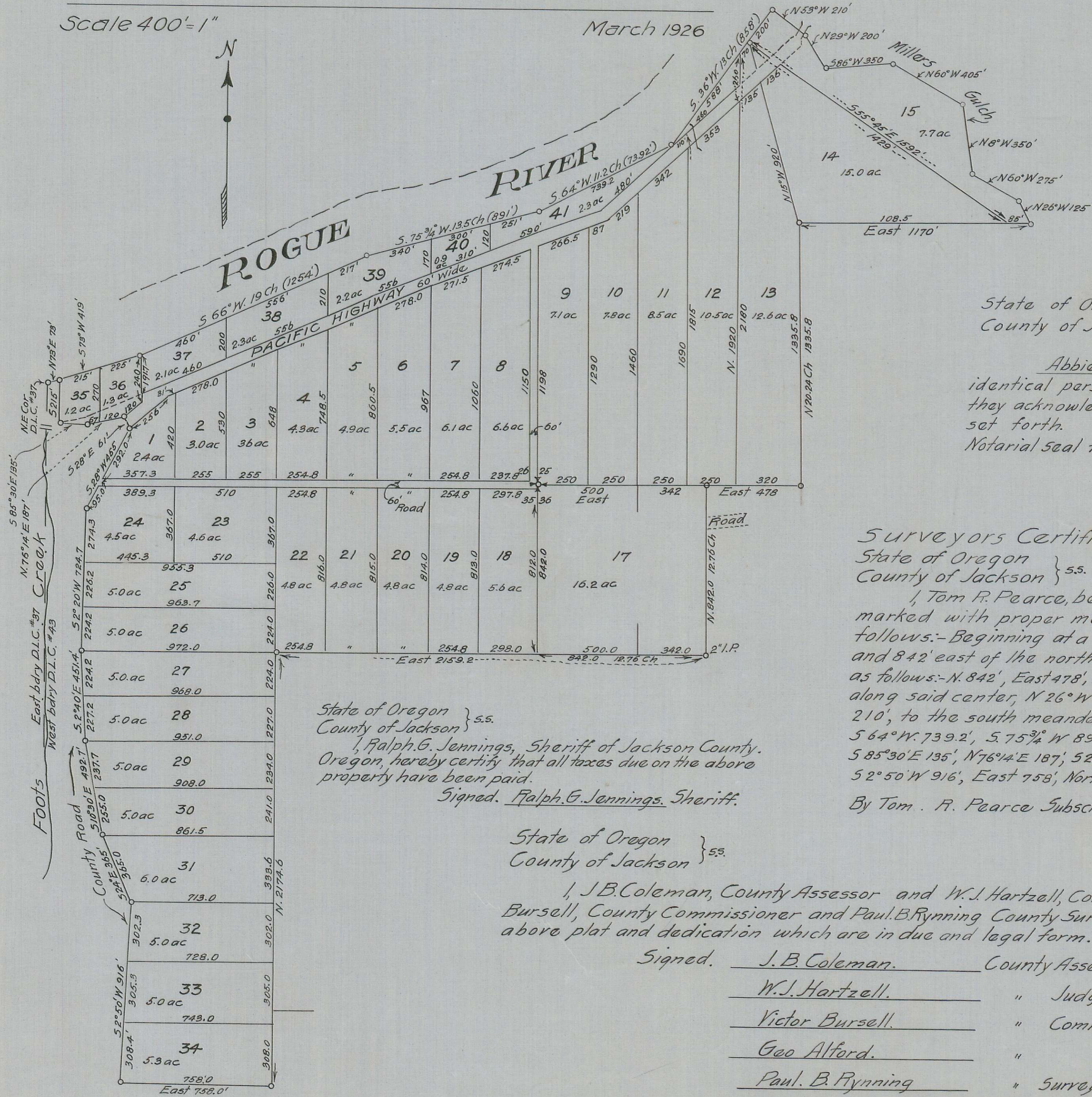


CHAMPLIN SUB-DIVISION

I, Tom R. Pearce, being first duly sworn depose and say that I surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands hereon shown, which are described as follows:- Beginning at a corner of D.L.C. #43 said corner being a point which is 842' south and 842' east of the northwest corner of section 36, T.36 S. R. 4 W. W. M; thence running as follows:- N. 842', East 478', North 1335.8', East 1170' to the center of Millers Gulch, thence running along said center, N 26° W 125', N 60° W 275', N 8° W 350', N 60° W 405', 586° W 350', N 29° W 200', N 53° W 210', to the south meander line of Rogue River, thence along the meander line 536° W 858', 564° W 739.2', 575° W 891', 566° W 1254', 573° W 419', thence leaving the meander, South 215', 585° 30' E 135', N 76° 14' E 187', 528° E 61', 528° W 455', 52° 20' W 724.7', 52° 40' E 451.4', 51° 30' E 492.7', 524° E 365', 52° 50' W 916', East 758', North 2174.6', East 2159.2' to the point of beginning.
