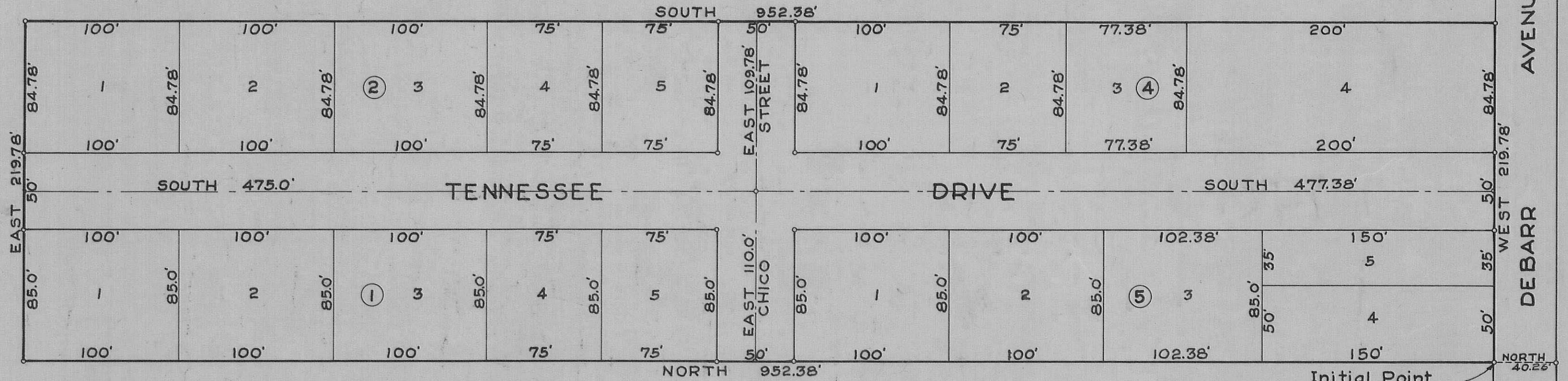


# H.H. WADLER SUBDIVISION

I, a duly registered engineer of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the survey made by me on the ground; that I planted a proper monument as provided by law, a concrete monument set six inches below the surface of the ground, indicating the initial point of said survey, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines of the subdivision;

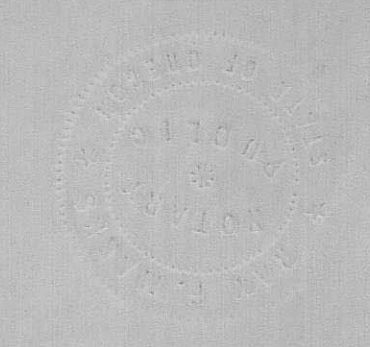
