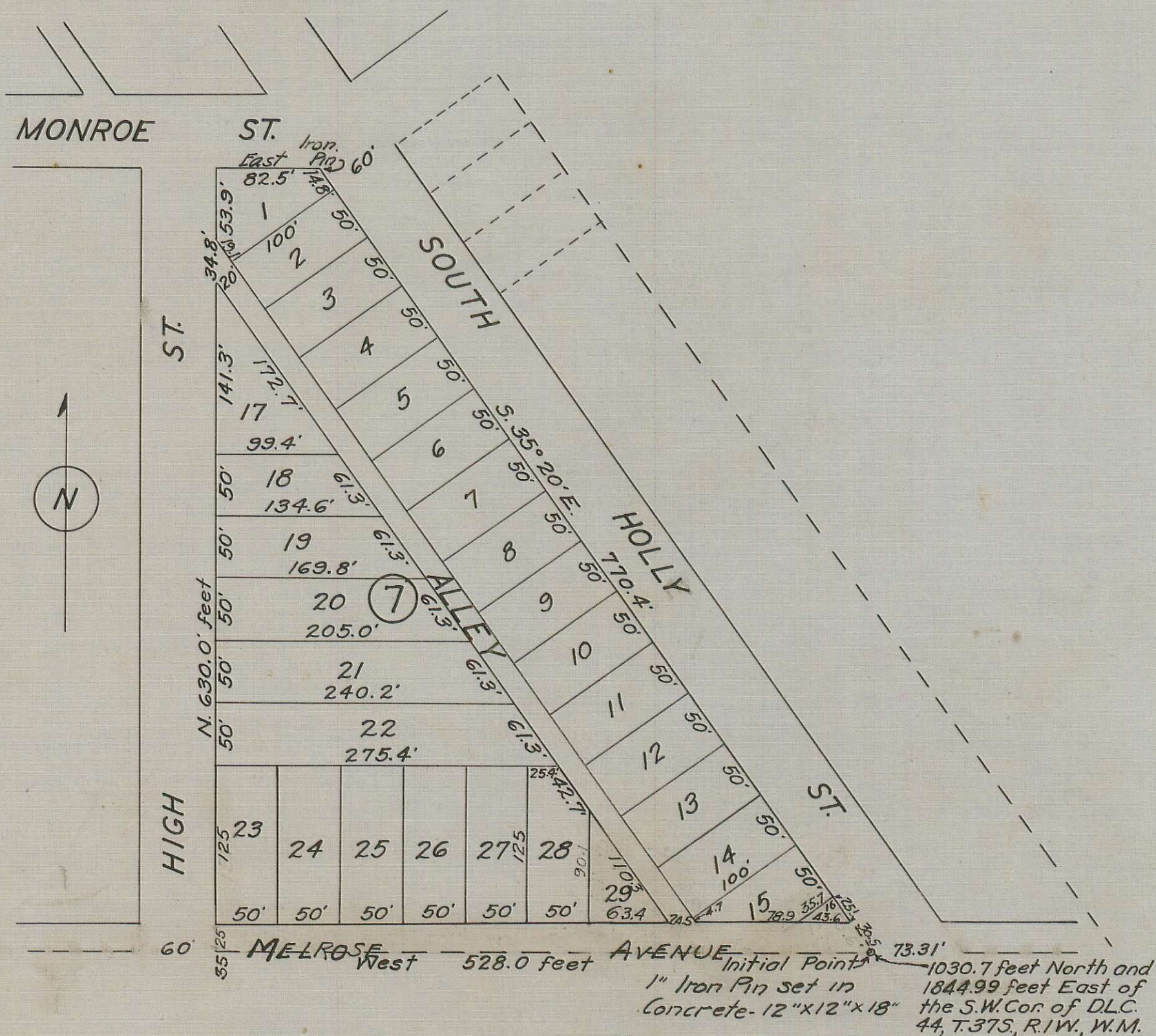


AMENDED PLAT OF BLOCKS 7 AND 8 SOUTH PARK ADDITION TO MEDFORD OREGON

MARCH 1928. H. D. POWELL CIVIL ENG'R.

DESCRIPTION

Commencing at the Southeast Corner of Block 8, South Park Addition to Medford, Oregon, said point being further described as being 1030.7 feet North, and 1844.99 feet East of the Southwest Corner of Donation Land Claim No. 44, Township 37 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon, and from said point running thence West 528.0 feet to the Southwest corner of Block 7, thence along the West line of Block 7, North 630.0 feet to the Northwest corner of Block 7; thence along the North line of said Block 7 East 82.5 feet to the Westerly line of South Holly Street; thence South 35° 20' East along the said Westerly line of the Street, also the Northeasterly line of said Blocks 7 and 8, 770.42 feet to the place of commencing, being all of said Blocks 7 and 8 of South Park Addition, the alley in said Block 7, and Alta Street, lying between said Blocks.

DEDICATION

Know all men by these presents, that we, C.I. Hutchison and Mattie M. Hutchison, his wife, Bessie F. Lumsden, a widow, as an individual, and as Executrix of the Estate of H.U. Lumsden, Deceased, C.W. Palm and Callie Palm, his wife, are the owners in fee simple of the above described tract, and that we have amended the original plat of the same and re-subdivided said tract into lots as shown hereon, and the number and size of the lots, and the length of all lines are plainly set forth, and that this plat is a correct representation of said amended subdivision, and we do hereby dedicate to the Public for public use the Alley shown hereon, and we do hereby designate said re-subdivision as the amended Plat of Blocks 7 and 8, South Park Addition to Medford, Oregon.
