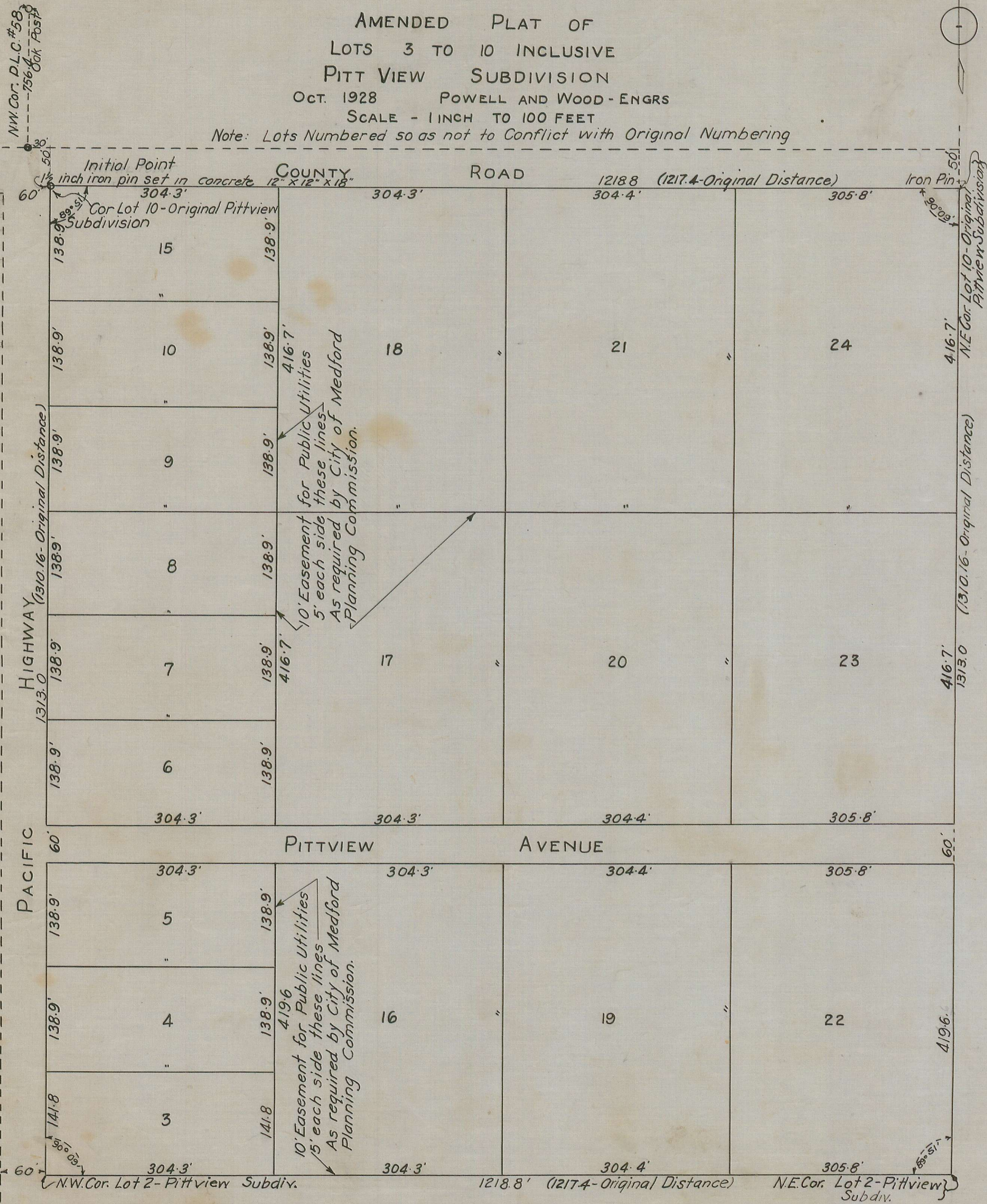


AMENDED PLAT OF
LOTS 3 TO 10 INCLUSIVE
PITT VIEW SUBDIVISION

DESCRIPTION

Beginning at an iron axle set in concrete, which is South 756.4 feet, East 30 feet, and South 50 feet from an oak post set for the North West Corner of Donation Land Claim #58, in Township 37 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, said iron pin being the North West corner of Lot 10 of the original plat of Pittview Subdivision, and being on the East line of the Pacific Highway, and from said point running South along the East line of the Highway 1313.0 feet; to the North West corner of Lot 2, Pittview Subdivision; thence at an angle to the left of 89°51' -1218.8 feet to the North East corner of said Lot 2; thence at an angle to the left of 90°09' 1313.0 feet to the North East corner of said Lot 10; thence at an angle to the left of 89°51' -1218.8 feet to the place of beginning and being Lots 3-4-5-6-7-8-9 and 10 of the original Pittview Subdivision recorded in Plat Book #5, on page 18, of the Plat Records of Jackson County.

DEDICATION
