

DESCRIPTION.

Commencing at a 1/4" iron pin, set in concrete, 12"x12"x18", said pin being S.72°54'W. 41.8 feet from a 1 1/2" iron pipe set for the North East Corner of Donation Land Claim #46, in Tp. 37 South, Range 1 West, W.M., and from said pin running thence S.5°16'W. 2627.4 feet to a 1/4" iron pin set in concrete 12"x12"x18", which pin is on the Easterly line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific Railroad; and running thence S.35°08'E. along said right of way 713.7 feet; thence S.88°32'E. 129.6 feet to the Westerly line of the Pacific Highway, at a point on a curve to the West, of radius 5700 feet; thence along said curve 179.2 feet; thence N.42°26'W. along the said Highway 142.5 feet; thence N.51°25'E. 2257.0 feet; thence N.3°54'W. 585.1 feet to the place of beginning. Excepting private roadway to Hanson tract, as shown by plat.
