## SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

I, C. Z. Boyden being first duly sworn this 24th day of July 1931, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the tract of land here on shown on said plat is a correct representation of said survey as made by me on the ground. That I planted a proper monument as provided by law, to wit: A two inch by thirty six inch galvanized pipe set six inches below the surface of the ground, indicating the Initial Point of said Survey, the same being located as follows: Commencing at the North east corner of Donation Land Claim Number 50, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian as described by United States survey field notes; thence S. 89° 54' W. 30.0 feet; thence N. 0° 06' W. 30.0 feet to the Initial Point; thence I run S. 89° 54' W. parallel to the North boundary of said D. L. C. Number 50, 1091.65 feet; thence N. 0° 17' E. 892.65 feet; thence S. 89° 33' E. 70.60 feet; thence S. 48° 33' E. 165.50 feet to the P.C.; thence following the arc of a 170.0 feet radius curve to the left 111.92 feet to the P.C.C.; thence following the arc of a 510.23 feet radius curve to the left 120.50 feet; thence N. 7° 25' W. 223.15 feet thence N. 84° 11' E. 419.52 feet to the P.C.; thence following the arc of a 1357.93 feet radius curve to the right 485.45 feet; thence S. 75° 20' E. 229.70 feet; thence S. 10° 40' W. 463.15 feet to the P.C.; thence following the arc of a 485.77 feet radius curve to the

right 377.15 feet to the P.T.; thence S. 55° 09' W. 108.25 feet to the P.C. thence following the arc of a 105.67 feet radius curve to the left 101.90 feet to the Initial Point.

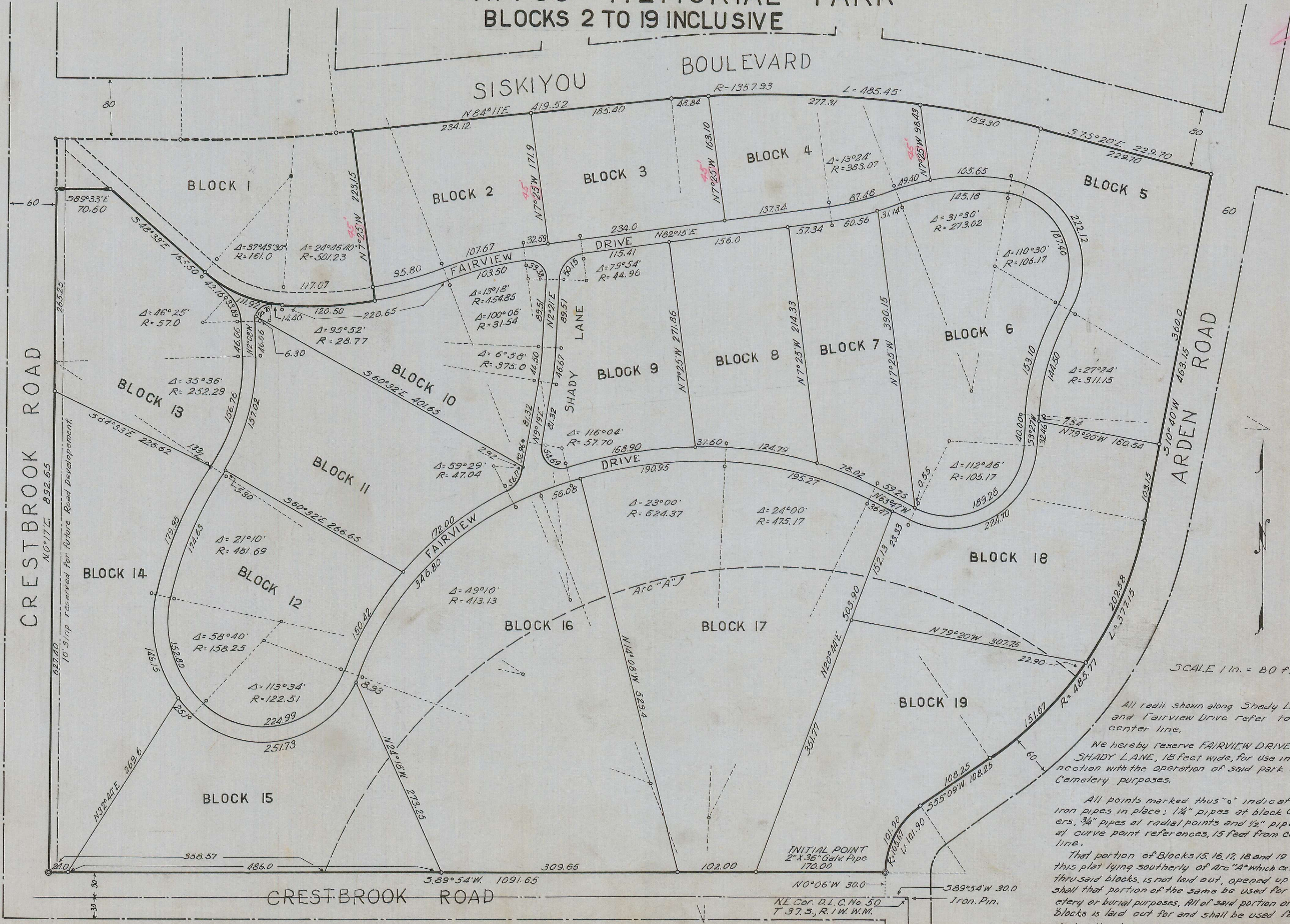

# SISKIYOU MEMORIAL PARK

## BLOCKS 2 TO 19 INCLUSIVE



SCALE 1 in. = 80 ft.

All radii shown along Shady Lane and Fairview Drive refer to center line.

We hereby reserve FAIRVIEW DRIVE and SHADY LANE, 18 feet wide, for use in connection with the operation of said park for Cemetery purposes.

All points marked thus "o" indicate iron pipes in place; 1/4" pipes at block corners, 3/4" pipes at radial points and 1/2" pipes at curve point references, 15 feet from center line.

That portion of Blocks 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 of this plat lying southerly of Arc "A" which extends thru said blocks, is not laid out, opened up nor shall that portion of the same be used for Cemetery or burial purposes. All of said portion of said blocks is laid out for and shall be used for Horticultural and Greenhouse purposes only.
