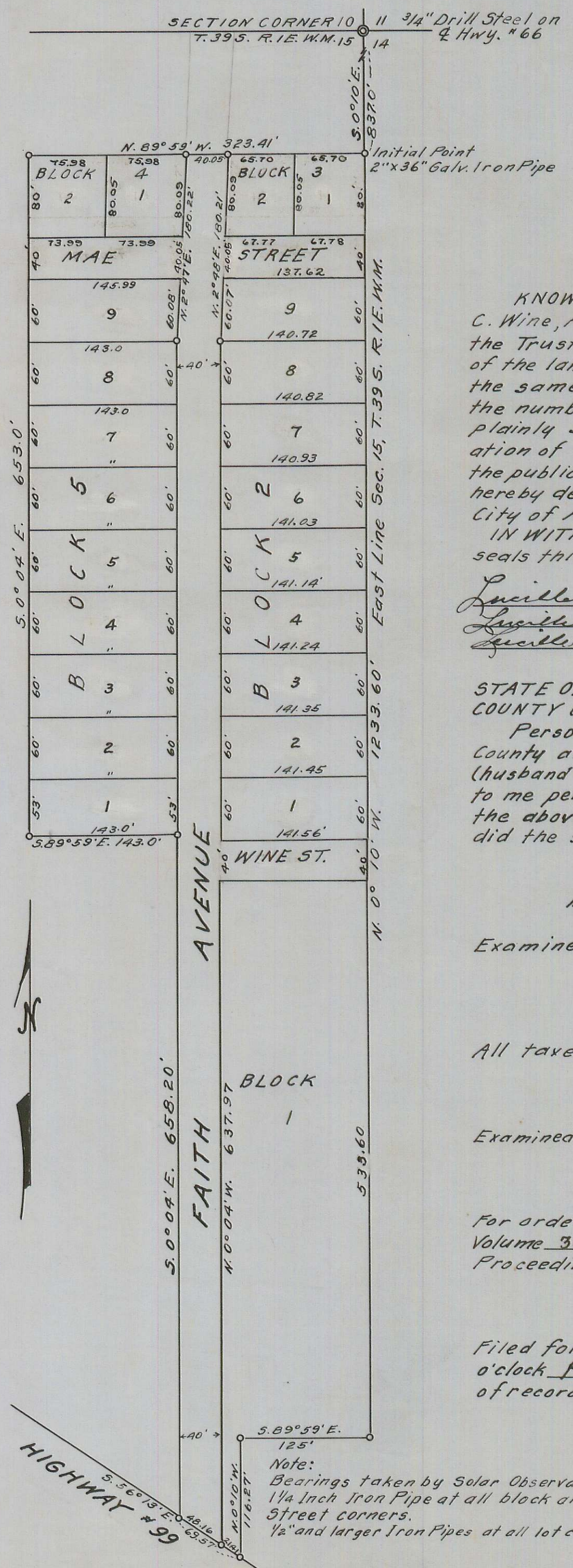


# FAITH SUBDIVISION

### SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

STATE OF OREGON }  
COUNTY OF JACKSON }  
I, L. E. AGER, a duly registered surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the survey made by me on the ground; that I planted a proper monument as provided by law, a two-inch by thirty-six-inch galvanized iron pipe set six inches below the surface of the ground, indicating the initial point of said survey, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines of the subdivision:  
Beginning at a point on the east line of Section 15, T. 39 S. R. 1 E. W. M., Oregon, which point is 5.0°10'E. 837.0 feet from the northeast corner of said Section; thence N. 89°59'W. 323.41 feet; thence 5.0°04'E. 653.0 feet; thence S. 89°59'E. 143.0 feet; thence S. 0°04'E. 658.20 feet; to the north-easterly right-of-way line of Highway #99; thence along said line S. 56°13'E. 69.57 feet; thence N. 0°10'W. 116.27 feet; thence S. 89°59'E. 125.0 feet to the east line of said section; thence along said section line N. 0°10'W. 1233.60 feet to the point of beginning.
