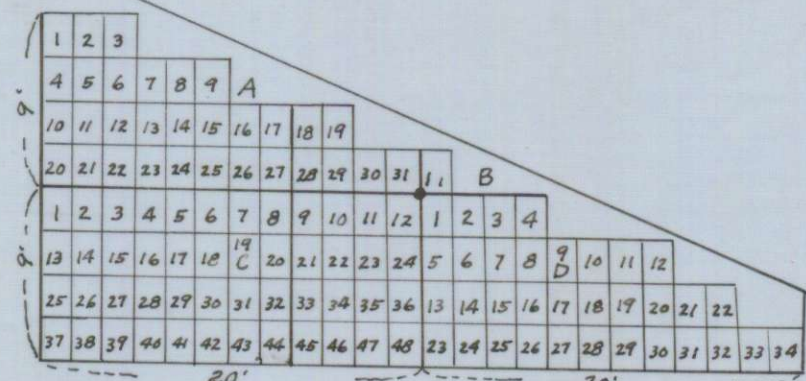
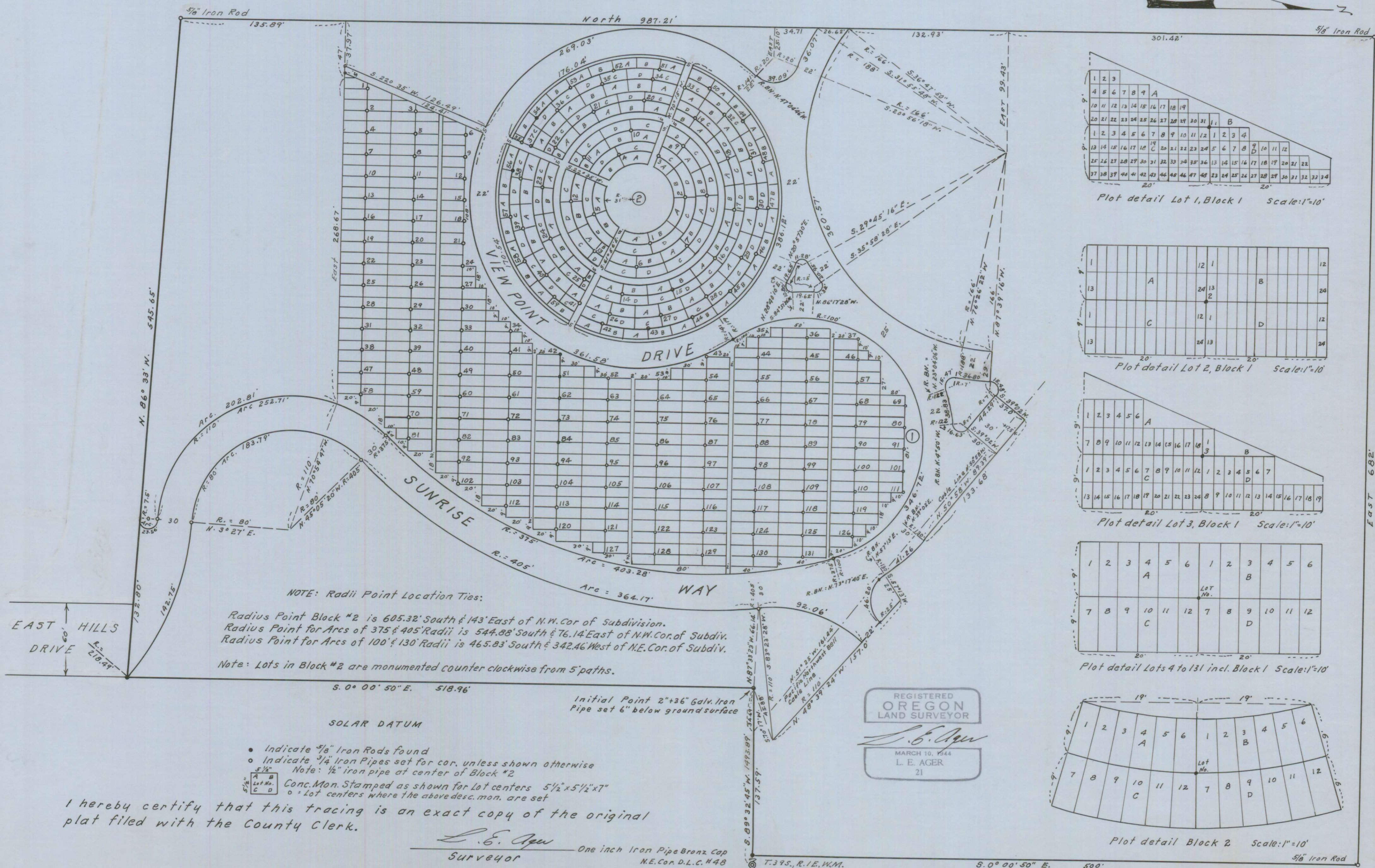

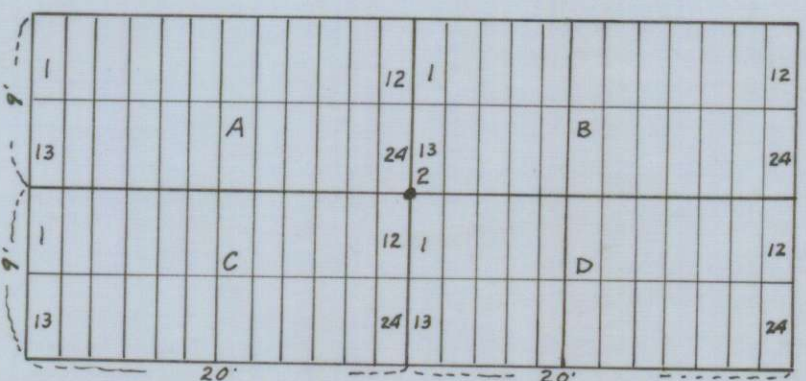
SCENIC HILLS MEMORIAL PARK

LOCATED IN D.L.C. NO. 48 & SECTIONS 2 & 11, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

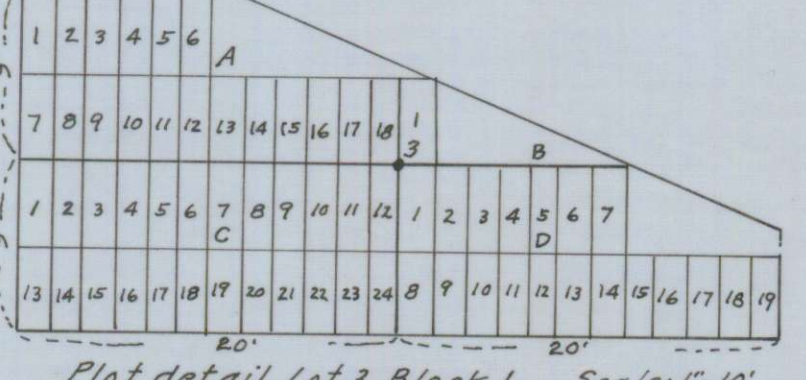

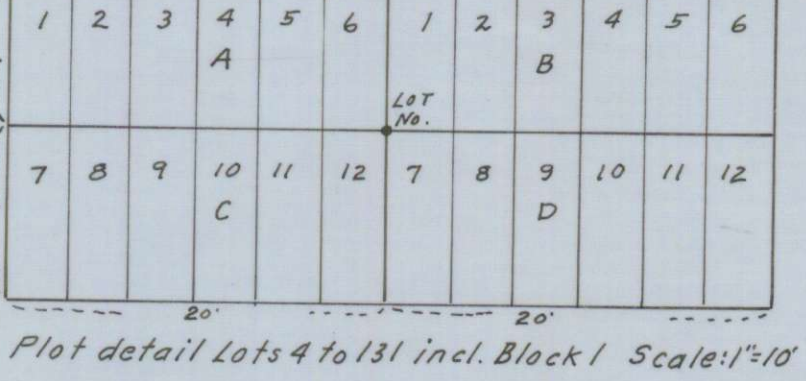
Plot detail Lot 1, Block 1 Scale: 1"=10'



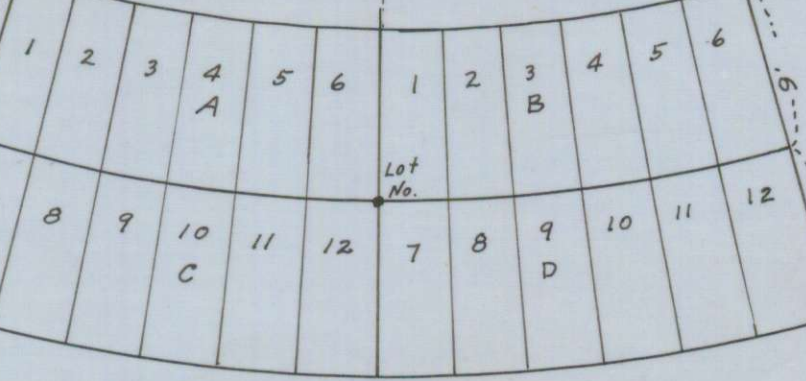
Plot detail Lot 2, Block 1 Scale: 1"=10'
