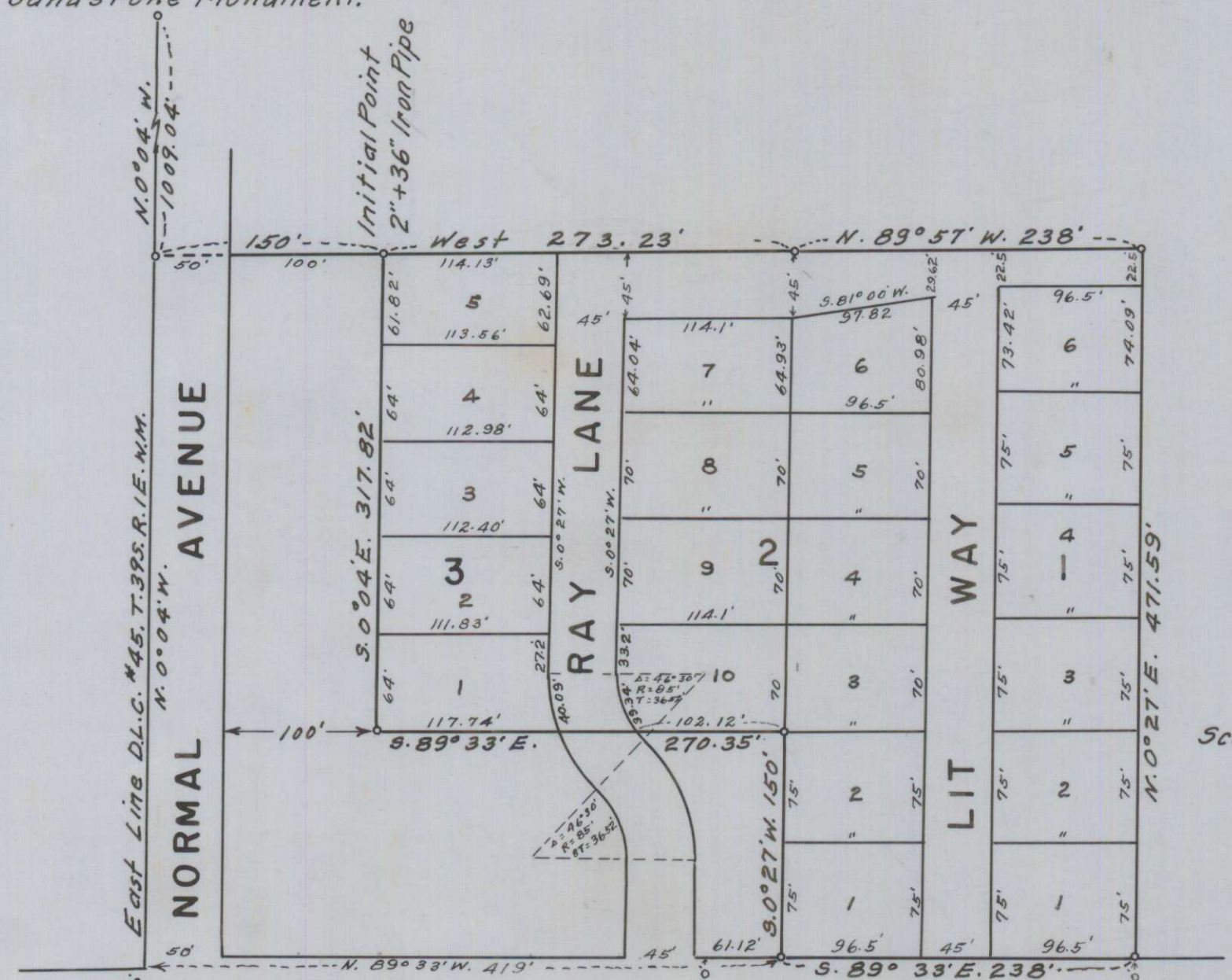

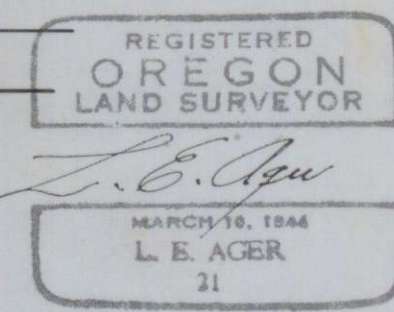

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, L. E. Ager a duly registered surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the survey made by me on the ground; that I planted a proper monument as provided by law, a two-inch by thirty-six-inch galvanized iron pipe set six inches below the surface of the ground, indicating the initial point of said survey, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines of the subdivision: Beginning at a point which bears N.0°04'W. 1009.04 feet and West 150.0 feet from the Southeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 45, T.39 S. R.1 E. W.M., Jackson County, Oregon; thence West 273.23 feet; thence N.89°57'W. 238.0 feet; thence N.0°27'E 471.59 feet to a point 30 feet distant from the center-line of Highway No. 66; thence parallel with said Highway center line S.89°33'E. 238.0 feet; thence S.0°27'W. 150 feet; thence S.89°33'E. 270.35 feet; thence S.0°04'E. 317.82 feet to the point of beginning.
