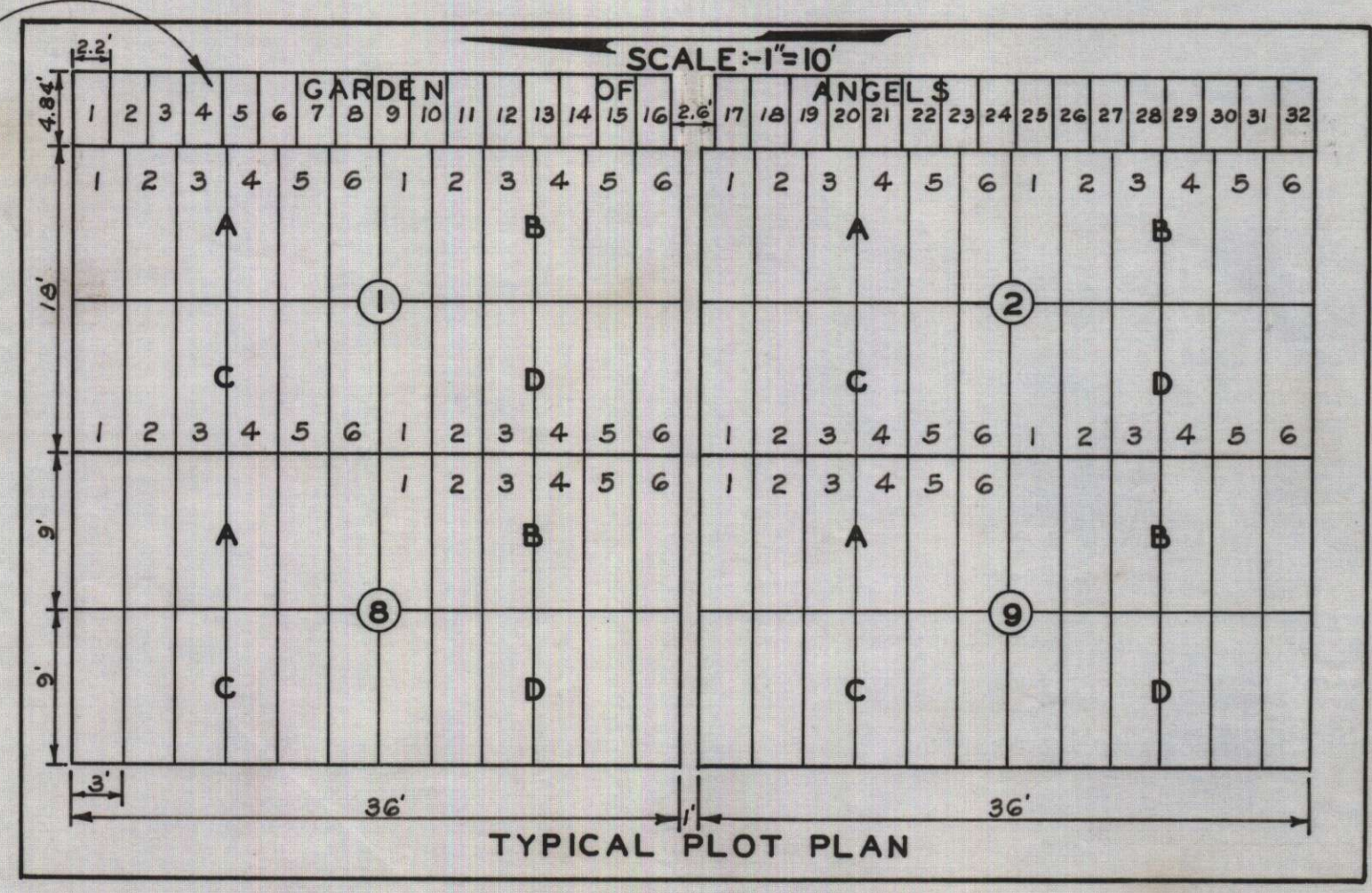
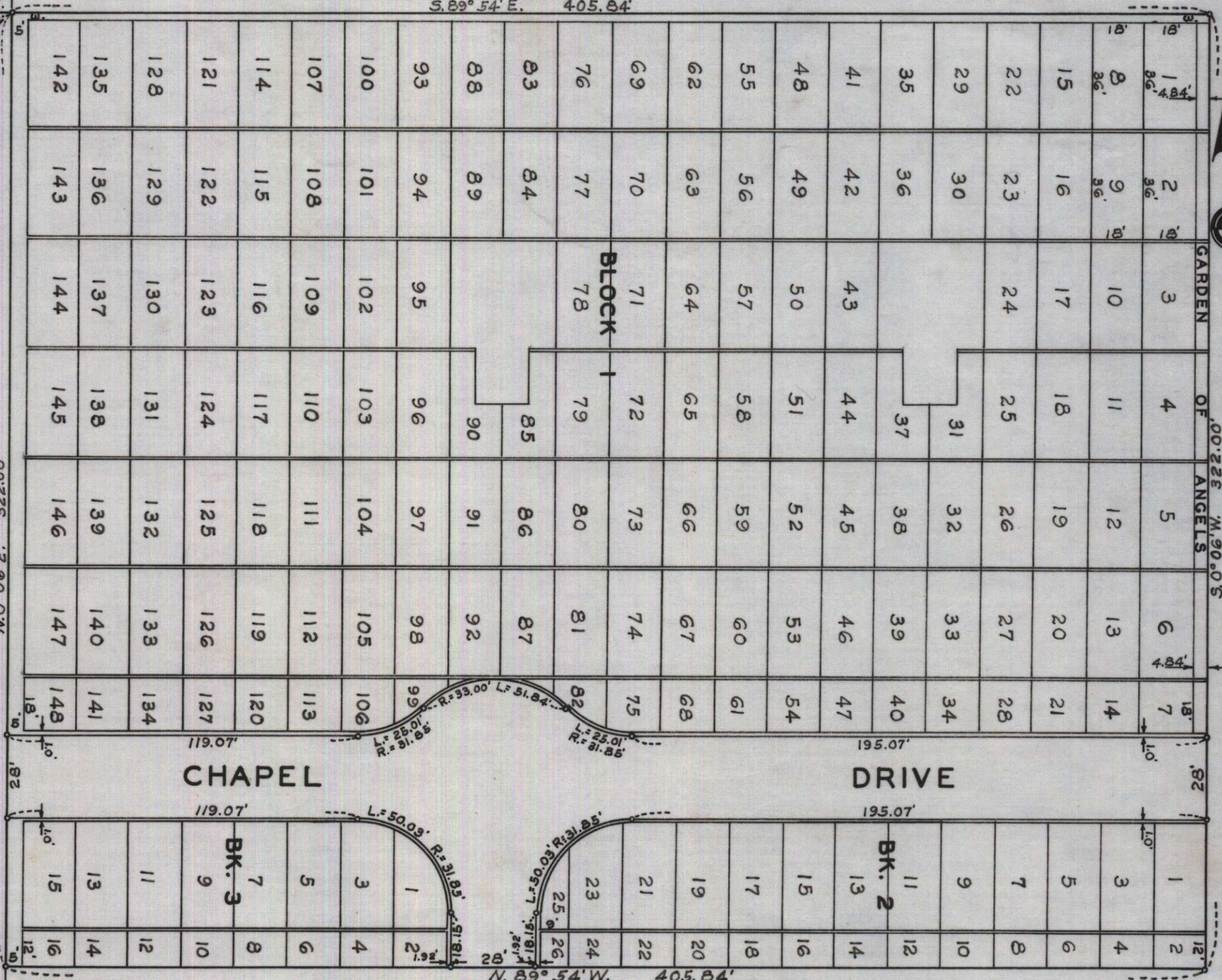

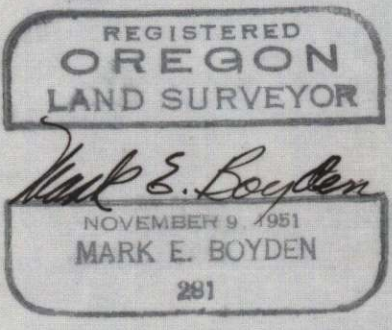
SCALE: - 1" = 40'
