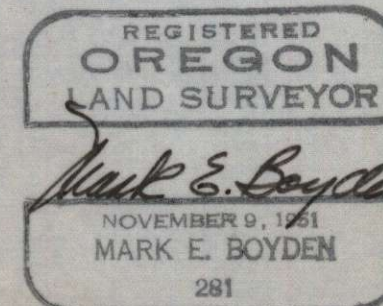

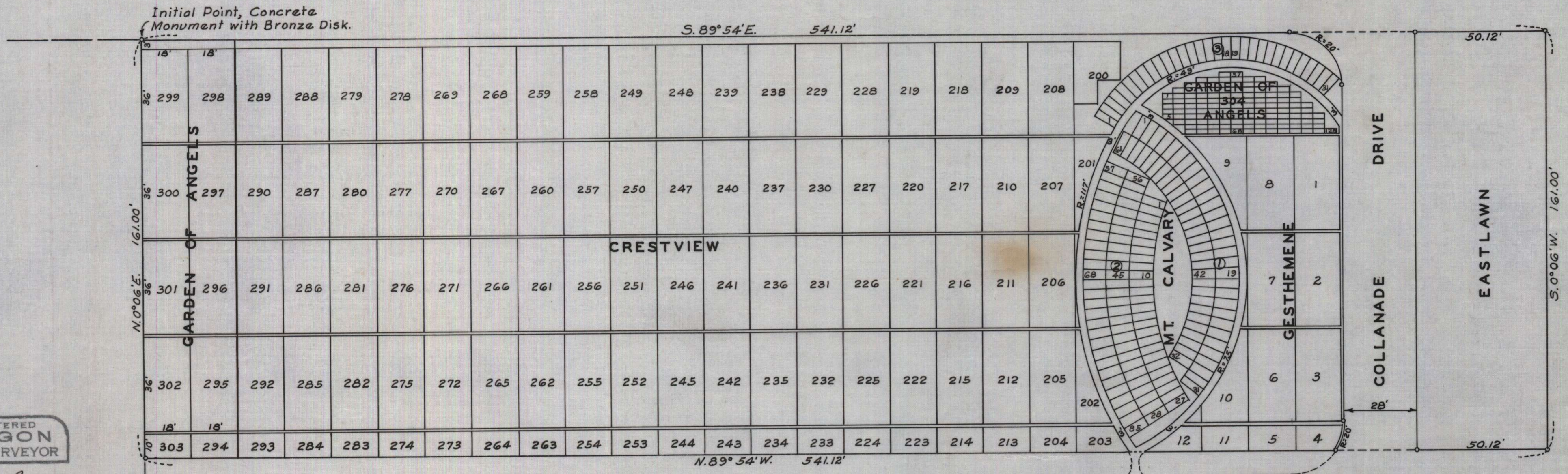

NOTE:
The 3 radius points for the Mt. Calvary section are monumented with 3/4" galvanized iron pipe, the 75' radius point being located in the center of Lot 206 Crestview, the 117' radius point being located in the center of Collanade Drive, N. 0° 06' E., 66.00 feet from the south boundary of Unit No. 2 and the 49' radius point being located N. 89° 54' W., 70.50 feet and S. 0° 06' W., 62.86 feet from the N.W. corner of Eastlawn.
All blocks shown with a circle were monumented with 5/8" iron pins.
