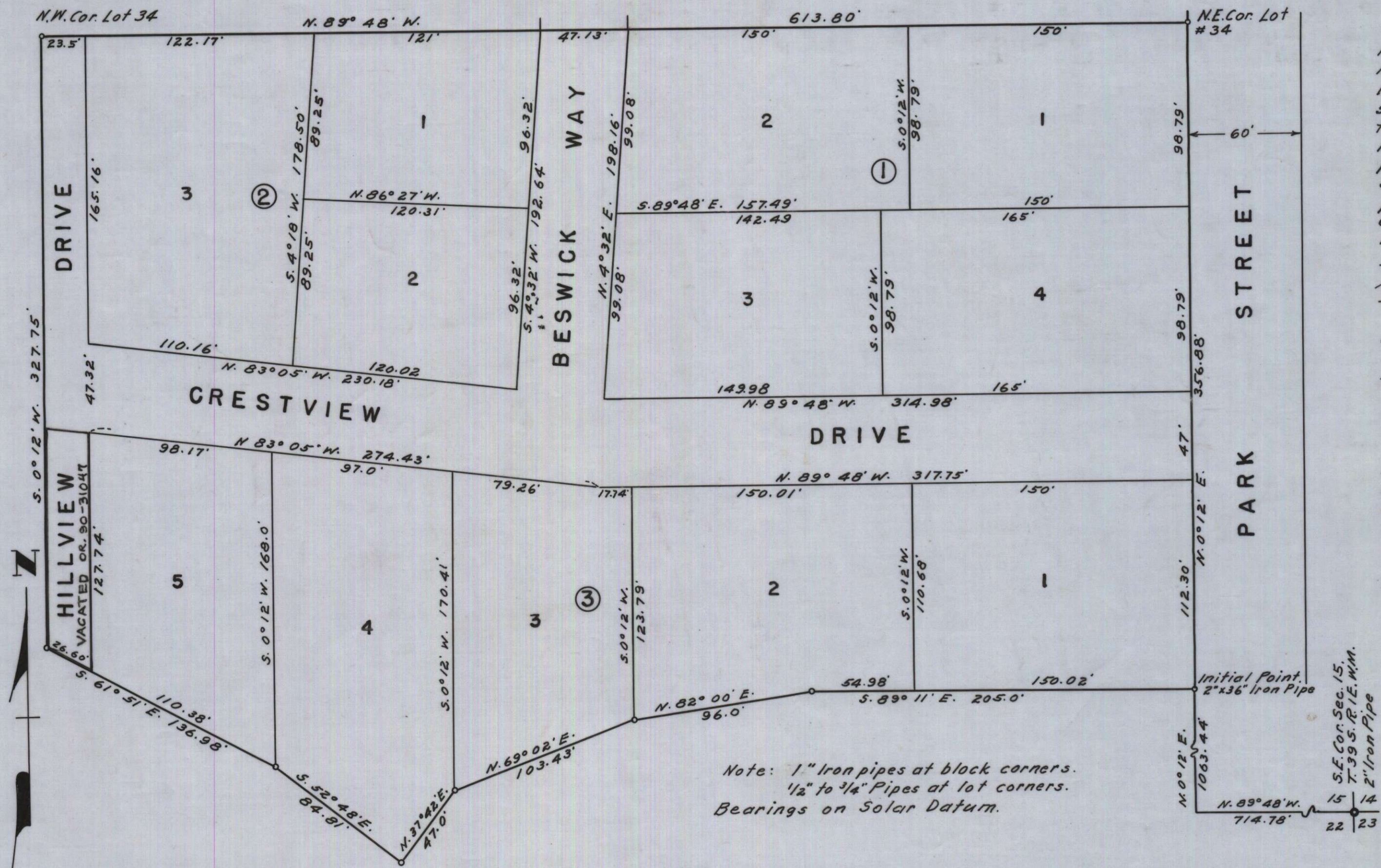


NORWOOD SUBDIVISION

I, L. E. Ager, a duly registered Surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments as provided by law the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines:

Beginning at a point on the east line of Lot 33, Bellview Tracts in Section 15, T. 39 S. R. 1 E. W.M., Jackson County, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof, now of record, which point bears S. 0° 12' W. 1.80 feet from the northeast corner of said Lot, said point also being N. 89° 48' W. 714.78 feet and N. 0° 12' E. 1063.44 feet from the southeast corner of said Section; thence N. 0° 12' E. 356.88 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 34 of said tracts; thence N. 89° 48' W. along the north line of said Lot 613.8 feet to the northwest corner thereof; thence S. 0° 12' W. along the west line of said Lot 327.75 feet to the northerly line of the Talent Irrigation District Canal; thence along said Canal as follows: S. 61° 51' E. 136.98 feet; thence S. 52° 48' E. 84.81 feet; thence N. 37° 42' E. 47.0 feet thence N. 69° 02' E. 103.43 feet; thence N. 82° 00' E. 96.0 feet; thence S. 89° 11' E. 205.0 feet to the point of beginning.
