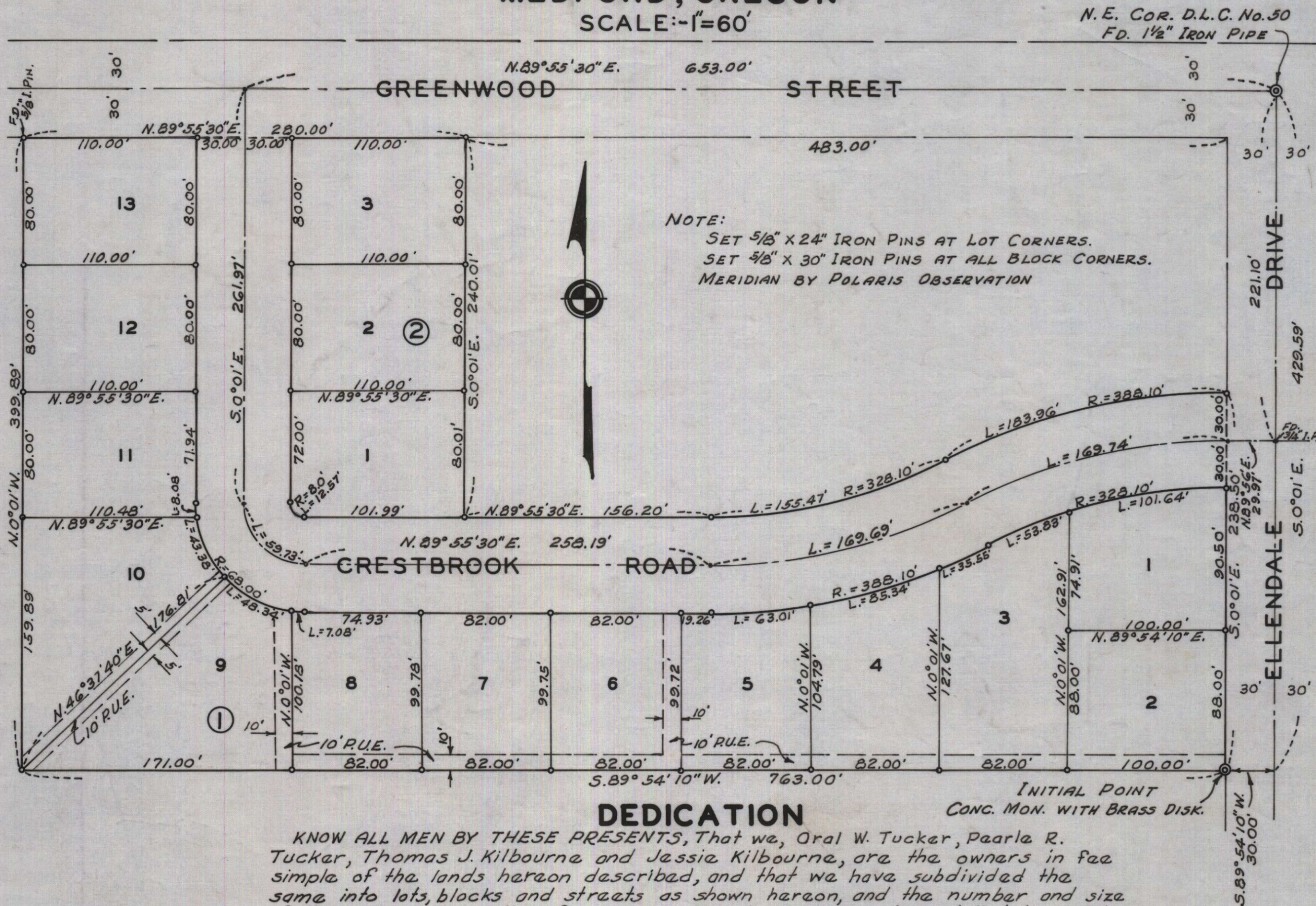


**CRESTVIEW SUBDIVISION**

**SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE**

I, Mark E. Boyden, a duly registered surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments as provided by law the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 50, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence S. 0° 01' E. along the East boundary of said claim 429.59 feet; thence S. 89° 54' 10" W., 30.00 feet to a concrete monument with brass disk located on the West boundary of Ellendale Drive for the initial point of beginning; thence S. 89° 54' 10" W., 763.00 feet; thence N. 0° 01' W., 399.89 feet to the South boundary of Greenwood Street; thence N. 89° 55' 30" E. along said street boundary 280.00 feet; thence S. 0° 01' E., 240.01 feet; thence N. 89° 55' 30" E., 156.20 feet; thence 155.47 feet on the arc of a curve left (which arc has a radius of 328.10 feet and a long chord of N. 76° 21' E., 154.02 feet) to a point of reverse curve; thence 183.96 feet on the arc of a curve right (which arc has a radius of 328.10 feet and a long chord of N. 76° 21' 15" E., 182.24 feet) to the West boundary of Ellendale Drive; thence S. 0° 01' E., 238.50 feet to the initial point of beginning.
