

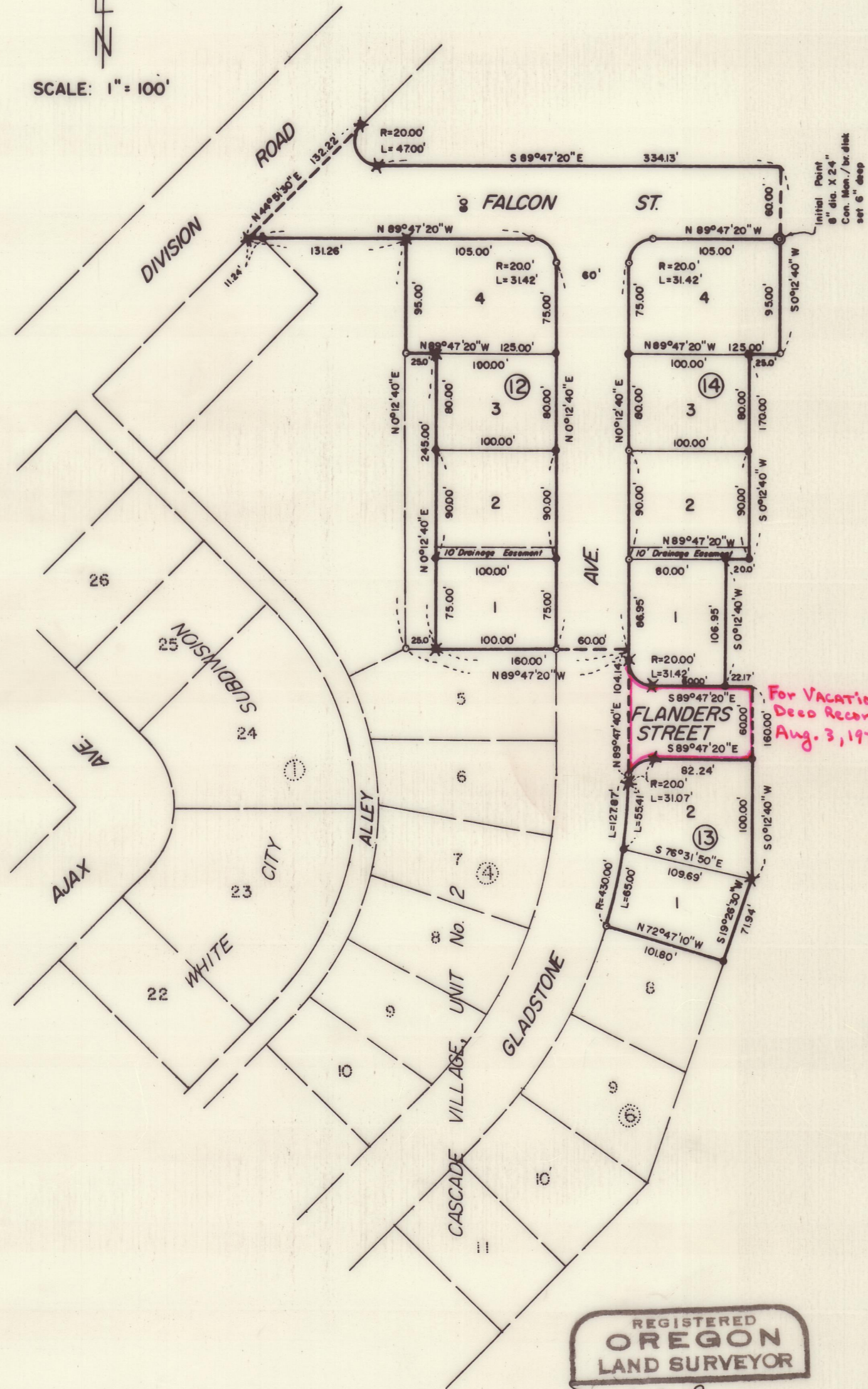
CASCADE VILLAGE, UNIT No. 4

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Mark E. Boyden a duly registered surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments as provided by law the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines: Commencing at the quarter corner common to sections 19 and 20, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence North 3302.86 feet; thence East 4608.26 feet to an 8" diameter by 24" concrete monument with bronze disk set 6" below the ground surface for the initial point of beginning; thence South 0°12'40" West, 95.00 feet; thence North 89°47'20" West, 25.00 feet; thence South 0°12'40" West, 170.00 feet; thence North 89°47'20" West, 20.00 feet; thence South 0°12'40" West, 106.95 feet; thence South 89°47'20" East, 22.17 feet; thence South 0°12'40" West, 160.00 feet; thence South 19°26'30" West, 71.94 feet to an intersection with the North-easterly boundary of Lot 8, Block 6, CASCADE VILLAGE UNIT No. 2, according to the official plat thereof; thence along said Lot boundary, North 72°47'10" West, 101.80 feet to the most Northerly corner of said Lot; thence along the Easterly boundary of Gladstone Avenue, along the arc of a curve left 127.87 feet, (which arc has a radius of 430.00 feet and a long chord of North 8°43'50" East, 127.40 feet); thence along said Avenue boundary, North 0°12'40" East, 104.14 feet; thence North 89°47'20" West, 160.00 feet to and along the North-easterly boundary of Lot 5, Block 4, of said CASCADE VILLAGE UNIT No. 2; thence North 0°12'40" East, 245.00 feet; thence North 89°47'20" West, 25.00 feet; thence North 0°12'40" East, 95.00 feet; thence North 89°47'20" West, 131.26 feet to the Southeasterly boundary of Division Road; thence along said Road boundary North 44°51'30" East, 132.22 feet, thence along the arc of a curve left 47.00 feet (which arc has a radius of 20.00 feet and a long chord of South 22°27'55" East, 36.91 feet); thence South 89°47'20" East, 334.13 feet; thence South 0°12'40" West, 60.00 feet to the initial point of beginning.
