ENGINEER'S CERTIFICATE

I, H.C. INGLE, a duly Registered Civil Engineer of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with the proper monuments as provided by law, the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines: Commencing at the Quarter corner common to Sections 28 and 29, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence North O° 18'25" West along the Section line between said Sections, 300 00 feet; thence East 30 feet to a 2 inch wide, 36 inch long iron pipe, located on the Easterly boundary of Duggan Road as described in Volume 188, page 394 of Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, said pipe being the Initial Point of Beginning; thence North 61°12' JO" East 77.35 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 120.03 feet along the arc of a curve right, with a radius High Calle of 23500 feet and a central angle of 29°16, the 'org chord of which bears North 75°50' East 118 74 feet; thence South 89° 32'00" East 685 00 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 107 35 feet along the arc of a curve left, with a radius of 135.28 feet and a central angle of 45°28'00', the long cord of which bears North 67° 44' OC" East 10456 feet, to the beginning of a reverse curve; thence 181.75 feet along the arc of a curve right, with a radius of 231.41 feet and a central angle of 45°, the long cord of which bears North 67°30'00" East 177.12 feet; thence East 160.58 feet; thence North 615.00 feet; thence East 400.00 feet; thence South 45.00 feet; thence East 449.18 feet to the North-South center line of said Section 28; thence South 0°15'00" East along said center line 1340.93 feet to a 5/8 inch steel pin on the Westerly boundary of Perry Road; thence South 33 52' West 133 A feet and South 33°36'30" West 63114 feet along said road boundary; 00" West 1548.30 feet; thence North 0° 19' 45" West 965.32 feet,

North 89°32'00" West along road boundary 45404 feet to the beginning of a curve; thence 89 38 feet along the arc of a curve left, with a radius of 175.00 feet and a central angle of 29°16, the long chord of which bears South 75°50'00' West 88 42 feet; thence South 61°12'00 West 109.91 feet to the Easterly boundary of said Duggan Road; thence North 0°18'25" West along said boundary 63.27 feet to the Initial Point of Beginning.
